This will be measured by 1) a 50% reduction in educational achievement gaps, 2) a decreasing poverty trend line for the county, and 3) a reduction in levels of abuse, neglect and unhealthy behaviors for the county that are at levels lower than the state. Many of these donations are specifically designated to qualified non-profit agencies. Acting as an agent, United Way ensures that these donations are collected and accurately distributed at least quarterly, under standards established by United Way Worldwide ) (Expenses \$ 781,135 including grants of \$ 678,209 ) (Revenue \$ Children Succeed In School United Way is a leader in two several community partnerships to improve youth success. The School Community Partnership Committee, co-led by United Way and Spokane Public Schools, collaborates with community organizations and school district staff to improve education outcomes for at-risk youth During the '13-'14 school year, 1,240 youth identified by the Spokane Public School District Early Warning System received targeted interventions (mentoring, tutoring, case management) to improve attendance, behavior and academic achievement. United Way also coordinated the Youth Program Quality Initiative (YPQI), which provided training, coaching and program assessment to nine organizations serving youth age 10-18. Funded by a grant from the Raikes Foundation, this project uses the Youth Program Quality Assessment developed by the David P. Weikart Center for Youth Program Quality. In addition, United Way funded community investments enabling 5,565 youth, ages 6 - 18, mostly low-income, to participate in seven out-of-school programs focused on skill building, academic enrichment, team building and volunteer engagement. Partners included Inland Northwest Council of Boy Scouts of America, Boys and Girls Club, Camp Fire, Communities In Schools, and Girl Scouts United Way funded in part an education program at a residential school run by Excelsion Youth Center, enabling 120 youth to receive education services, of which 75% of them earned significant credits toward high school graduation. United Way provided funding to the Salish School of Spokane, providing for a Salish language immersion program for fourteen Native American youth with a focus on language arts 100% of the participating children increased their reading scores by 1 5 levels on the Fountas and Pinnell scale ) (Expenses \$ 670,153 including grants of \$ 654,440 ) (Revenue \$ Health and Inclusion. United Way formed partnerships focusing on the following desired results, that children and youth are nurtured and safe, that people make healthy choices, that vulnerable populations can access health care, and that vulnerable populations are included, and can maintain wellness and independence. To those ends, funded programs provided the following services 89 caregivers participated in individual counseling and/or group education to improve parenting skills 35 youth received individual and school-based counseling to deal with death in the family, 500 teachers, counselors and administrators received safe schools training to ensure that all students, including GLBTQ students, feel welcomed and safe 631 youth placed in foster care received supports and counseling 355 youth received individual and group counseling due to domestic violence in their family 1,185 children and their families received services for victims of sexual assault and/or violent crime. United Way financed in part crisis response services, including a 24/7 hotline for domestic violence that handled 3,699 calls. 2,291 individuals dealing with domestic violence received a range of services including safety planning, temporary shelter, counseling, legal assistance, and housing and financial advocacy services 583 homeless youth received services included counseling and crisis intervention, resource information, and referrals for mental health, drug treatment health care, legal assistance, and financial support 123 clients living with AIDS received quarterly health check-ups and action plans to improve their health and prevent viral transmission to others 463 seniors participated in volunteer programs 236 youth received chemical dependency counseling, 507 adults received outpatient chemical dependency counseling Organizations and programs funded include the SafeT Response Center at Lutheran Community Services, Spokane Aids Network, YFA Connections, Volunteers of America, TeamChild Spokane, the Martin Luther King Jr Center, the Safe Schools Spokane Program at the Odyssey Youth Center, YMCA of the Inland Northwest, the Alternatives to Violence Program at YWCA of Spokane, Daybreak Youth Services, Excelsior Youth Center, Frontier Behavioral Health, Nexus Inland NW, the Adult Day Health Center and Home Health Care Programs of Providence Services, American Red Cross - Inland Northwest Chapter, the ARC of Spokane, and Lilac Services for the Blind (Code 268,427 261,282 ) (Revenue \$ ) (Expenses \$ including grants of \$ BASIC NEEDS United Way provided funding in part to the following programs and agencies focused on meeting basic needs. American Indian Community Center provided crisis intervention and case management for elders and their families, including food bank services to 4,691 individuals, and advocacy, transportation, and education services. American Red Cross responded to 77 disaster incidents, and provided 405 individuals with emergency services including temporary shelter, food, and/or clothing as needed The ARC of Spokane provided advocacy services for 36 adults with developmental disabilities, improving circumstances such as housing, financial stability, legal rights, and abuse, exploitation and neglect. The Family Emergency Services program at the Martin Luther King Jr. Center served 1,648 families with information and referral services, 109 families received emergency financial for basic needs, and 42 families participated in life skills mentoring. Mid City Concerns provided 770 seniors with hot meals through their Meals on Wheels program. Salvation Army, Housing Stability and Empowerment program provided 40,763 individuals with food, 300 families were assisted with shelter, transitional housing, and rehousing services, and 635 individuals participated in Life Skills Classes. Second Harvest provided 8 97 million pounds of food to a network of 127 food banks, meal centers, and other hunger relief programs in Spokane County. 229,867 including grants of \$ 121,026 ) (Revenue \$ ) (Expenses \$ COMMUNITY PLANNING AND PUBLIC POLICY United Way, with a team of community volunteers, reviews and approves grants to programs run by partnering agencies that demonstrate accountability toward the desired results described under Education, Income and Health United Way stays informed of current community aspirations and concerns through community conversations and develops relationships with business, schools and government agencies. The resulting partnerships drive a more collaborative approach to change through community involvement, influencing public policy, and the design and delivery of high-impact human care services. United Way invests to connect those with needs to available resources by partnering with Frontier Behavioral Health in funding First Call for Help and the 2-1-1 information line. First Call for Help handled 93,900 calls, and 2-1-1 handled 22,208 calls and over 30,000 referrals. These resources serve as crisis support, information, assistance, and referral services. Spokane County United Way has been a long-time member of the United Ways of Washington, working to collaborate effectively on state-wide issues 135,731 ) (Revenue \$ (Code ) (Expenses \$ 218,233 including grants of \$ FINANCIAL STABILITY Spokane County United Way coordinates the Spokane County CASH Coalition (CASH stands for Creating Assets, Savings & Hope) Members of the CASH Coalition include representatives from financial institutions, social service providers, education partners and government agencies. Their work encompasses financial education and counseling, second chance banking, and free tax preparation. During the year, 70 people received one-on-one financial coaching, 892 individuals received basic money management and credit classes, an estimated 247 individuals took advantage of targeted second-chance banking programs, and 4,896 individuals received free tax preparation services. United Way was a funding partner for the Women's Opportunity Center at the YWCA, providing job readiness training, professional clothing, childcare services, networking, referrals, and emotional supports to 2,032 economically disadvantaged women seeking employment. The Next Generation Zone provided financial education and coaching to 70 youth who recently began their first job. The Financial Access program at SNAP provided financial education, coaching, credit counseling, small business counseling, and access to credit to several hundred participants, resulting in 22 improved credit scores, 83 unbanked clients opening bank accounts, 81 businesses started, expended, or enhanced, and 72 jobs created, retained or increase in income. The Housing Counseling program at SNAP provided classes for potential homeowners and counseling for households facing mortgage foreclosure/default, resulting in 267 clients saving their home from foreclosure and 14 clients purchasing their first home ) (Expenses \$ including grants of \$ 172,610 ) (Revenue \$ EARLY LEARNING Experiences in the first five years of life help determine whether a child will be successful in school and life. United Way is focusing on helping parents and child care providers get children off to a good start. We participate in the Inland Northwest Alliance for Early Learning, through which representatives of public health, early learning, public library, K-12, local government and local philanthropies are working together to create a sustainable early learning system that prepares all children for success 5,000 kindergarten readiness calendars were distributed to parents and teachers throughout the county, providing activities to do with four-year-olds throughout the year to help them be ready on the first day of kindergarten. United Way funded curriculum development and training at Blueprints for Learning to improve the quality of care provided at Spokane area child care centers through increasing the skills and knowledge of the providers Blueprints for Learning delivered training for child care staff to help their programs excel in Washington State's new quality rating system 309 child care staff, and 104 child care directors and leaders received training. At Spokane Guilds' School, 141 children with disabilities under the age of three were seen monthly and received early intervention services. Of the 85 children transitioning out of services, 100% showed improved development skills and 19% will require no further specialized education services. United Way provided funding for quality child care at Spokane's Central YMCA, and the Martin Luther King Jr. Center for 205 children ages four weeks through five years, focusing on developmentally appropriate curriculum for infants, toddlers, pre-schoolers and pre-kindergarteners 94% of 5-year olds were assessed as ready for kindergarten 163,247 including grants of \$ EXCELERATE SUCCESS, spearheaded by United Way, is a community partnership focused on preparing all of our region's children for success in school and in life The mission is for every child in Spokane County to be cared for, confident, and competent - from cradle to career. In the '13-'14 year, Excelerate Success created its baseline report, found at exceleratesuccess org, defining a data-driven framework of goals, and core and contributing indicators, across an education continuum that includes kindergarten readiness, success in primary, middle school, high school, through career readiness. This partnership has been funded by Wells Fargo, the Gates Foundation, Target Foundation, and Lumina Foundation and is part of a nationwide Strive Partnership with similar collective impact networks in dozens of communities across the country. To date, Excelerate Success has established several collaborative action networks, or project teams consisting of cross-sector practitioners, working on Kindergarten Readiness, 3rd Grade Reading, Post Secondary Enrollment, and Post-Secondary Completion including grants of \$ CHILDREN NURTURED AND SAFE United Way provided funding in part for the following programs focused on the safety and nurturing of children At Children's Home Society, the Parents as Teachers Program teaches parenting skills to at-risk parents of 53 children ages birth to age 2 The Child Welfare Program at Lutheran Community Services provides mental health care and therapeutic foster care to children who have experienced abuse and neglect 23 people received foster care and 190 people received mental health treatment. At the Martin Luther King Jr. Family Relationship Training Program, parenting education was provided for 58 parents and other caregivers of children of all ages using the Circle of Security model. At Sally's House, a receiving care facility run by the Salvation Army for children removed from their families due to suspected child abuse and neglect, 187 children received emergency foster care and 421 children (261) families received counseling services and supervised visitation with parents. The Child Advocacy Program run by the YWCA, provided counseling, safety training, and peer support groups for over 400 youth and parents who have been exposed to domestic violence in their home (Code ) (Expenses \$ 116,035 including grants of \$ 6,783) (Revenue \$ VOLUNTEER SERVICES United Way serves as a volunteer center for Spokane County, coordinating opportunities for individuals and groups to volunteer with local nonprofit organizations. United Way's operates a robust online website, volunteerspokane org, of current volunteer opportunities and volunteers. In the service year, United Way handled 912 referrals for volunteerism, resulting in 369 matches and approximately 4,194 volunteer hours. United Way also worked with a total of 3,243 volunteers directly in a variety of capacities including fundraising, tax return preparation, participation on governance and policy committees, and our annual Day-of-Service activities. In April of 2014, United Way collaborated with the City of Spokane in its inaugural Spokane Gives Week, a time to celebrate and encourage volunteerism and other acts of service. United Way provided the online website, VolunteerSpokane org to assist in matching community needs and volunteers. Spokane Gives Week saw 6,826 volunteering at 105 volunteer projects offered by 82 community-based organizations (many of which used the VolunteerSpokane org site). United Way collaborated with Freeman High School to pilot a Varsity Letter in Community Service Program. Each student who fulfilled 145 hours of community service earned a letterman's patch and a Volunteer Service Award from President Obama (Code 36,421 ) (Expenses \$ including grants of \$ 0) (Revenue \$
