FOR THESE EMPLOYEES, SALARY RANGE IS DETERMINED AT THE TIME OF POSITION RECRUITMENT BY REVIEWING COMPARABLE SALARY DATA COMPILATIONS FOR SIMILAR POSITIONS AT SIMILARLY SITUATED ORGANIZATIONS IN BOTH NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL GROUPS AND ALASKA'S NONPROFIT SECTOR. SALARY REVIEW IS PERFORMED BY THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, DISCUSSED WITH THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, AND RECORDED WITH SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION BY THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR. THE REVIEW PROCESS CAN BE REINITIATED AT OTHER TIMES BY DETERMINATION OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR. THE PERSONNEL COMMITTEE CURRENTLY IS IN THE PROCESS OF REVIEWING COMPENSATION AND HAVE ENGAGED A CONTRACTOR TO ANALYZE ACF'S COMPENSATION AS COMPARED TO OTHER CONSERVATION ORGANIZATIONS IN THE US AND NON-PROFITS IN ALASKA. WE EXPECT THAT THE REVIEW WILL BE COMPLETED BY MARCH 2015.
