Schedule I, Part I, Line 2

The philosophy of student aid is to provide access and choices to students, who without financial assistance would not be able to attend an institution of higher learning. The Director of Financial Aid is responsible for establishing Institutional policy development surrounding the delivery of financial assistance Policy development adheres to federal and state laws and regulations as well as to the mission of the University When appropriate, Financial Aid policy is reported to and approved by the Executive Vice President & Chief Operations Officer. The primary purpose of a collegiate financial aid program should be to provide financial assistance to accepted students who, without such aid, would be unable to attend that university Each university has an obligation to assist in realizing the national goal of equality of educational opportunity. The University, therefore, should work with schools, community groups, and other educational institutions in support of this goal Parents are expected to contribute according to their means, taking into account their income, assets, number of dependents, and other relevant information. Students themselves are expected to contribute from their own assets and earnings, including appropriate borrowing against future earnings. Need-based financial aid should be offered only after determination that the resources of the family are insufficient to meet the student's educational expenses. The amount of need-based aid offered should not exceed the amount needed to meet the difference between the student's total educational expenses and the family's resources. The amount and type of self-help expected from students should be related to the circumstances of the individual. In the assignment of funds to those students designated to receive financial aid, the largest amounts of total grant assistance should go to students with the least ability to pay. The university should review its financial assistance awards annually and adjust them, if necessary, to reflect changes in the financial needs of students and the expenses of attending the institution. The university has an obligation to inform students and parents of the financial aid renewal policies for enrolled students at the time of the initial offer of financial assistance. Because the amount of financial assistance awarded reflects the economic circumstances of students and their families as well as available funding, the university should refrain from any public announcement of the amount of aid offered and encourage students, their secondary schools, and others to respect the confidentiality of this information. Selection of students to receive financial aid will be made without regard to age, sex, race, color, religion, national origin, disability or marital status Priority consideration for aid is given to students whose files are complete by March 1 of each year. The institution will package each student according to the matrix (percentage) need assigned the student. This determination is made by the award year the student will enter. Once the matrix year is determined the student is awarded a percentage of his or her (FAFSA) need with federal, state and institutional aid. The student is then awarded work study followed with Perkins loan, Stafford (subsidized or unsubsidized) loan and the PLUS loan, as applicable Aid is "frozen" from one year to the next. In extreme instances as defined by the Financial Aid. Office, the amount of grant money may be adjusted accordingly to reflect a students' new need. Honors scholarships are awarded based on the high school GPA, rank and either the SAT or ACT scores Students will continue to receive the scholarship as long as the student is in good academic standing. Award letters are mailed or emailed to the student whenever there is a change to the financial aid award and the change affects federal or state awards
