IN MANAGEMENT'S OPINION, THE ESTIMATED LOSS IS REASONABLE AND THE EMBEZZLEMENT IS AN ISOLATED CASE. THE FORMER EMPLOYEE SUSPECTED OF THE EMBEZZLEMENT WAS ARRESTED AND HAS PLEADED NO CONTEST. THE CENTER WILL SEEK RESTITUTION THROUGH A COMBINATION OF ACTIONS INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RESTITUTION FROM THE FORMER EMPLOYEE AND CLAIMS AGAINST FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS AND THE CENTER'S INSURANCE CARRIER COVERING EMPLOYEE DISHONESTY COVERAGE. AT JUNE 30, 2014 AND 2013, THE OPERATING FUND INCLUDES THE ACCRUAL FOR THE LOSS OF \$385,000 AND A PAYABLE TO THE CLIENT TRUST FUND WHEN THE CENTER RECEIVES RESTITUTION, IT WILL RECOGNIZE INCOME AND WILL THEN USE THE PROCEEDS TO REIMBURSE THE IMPACTED CLIENTS BY TRANSFERRING THE FUNDS TO THE CLIENT TRUST FUND BECAUSE OF THE LIMITATIONS ON RECOGNIZING GAIN CONTINGENCIES, THE OPERATING FUND WILL RECOGNIZE RESTITUTION AS IT IS RECEIVED AS A RESULT, THERE IS AN UNRESTRICTED ACCUMULATED DEFICIT AS OF JUNE 30, 2014 AND 2013 SUBSEQUENT TO JUNE 30, 2014, THE CENTER HAS RECEIVED \$200,000 FROM ITS INSURANCE CARRIER
