As the Regional Center of an international network, we facilitate collaboration among more than 150 organizations in North America, linked to some 600 groups in more than 90 countries worldwide. At times our campaigns with network partners lead to creation of formal coalitions for which the Organization serves as facilitator, administrator and/or fiscal sponsor, making the coalition technically a project of the Organization. The most significant coalition sponsored by PAN North America in 2013–2014 was Californians for Pesticide Reform (CPR185 groups across the state, among which PAN is one of the leading members in policy advocacy work). In the last year CPR and PAN have worked with the state to promote sustainable alternatives to fumigants; CPR is managing a project in Kern and Fresno counties to overcome barriers preventing community members from reporting pesticide incidents and other
