#### NATURE OF AWARD

A scholarship committee, (of your high school), will review the applications, transcripts and letters of recommendation and select the winners and a sufficient number of alternates. Your counselor will forward this information to <u>First Financial Trust & Asset Management Co.</u>, <u>N.A.</u>, Trustee of The Elmer McKenney Scholarship Trust.

In the event the scholarship is not accepted or used wholly or in part by the recipient during the academic year for which it is granted, it will be offered to an alternate.

### PAYMENT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

Payment of the scholarship will be made as follows:

- A check payable jointly to the college/university for the benefit of the recipient will be mailed in August to the Scholarship/Financial Aid Office of the college/university. The student's account will be credited and funds held until the student registers.
