Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

The Neuwirth Foundation, Inc. (The Foundation) operates as a private foundation under section 501(c)(3) of The Internal Revenue Code. The significant accounting policies followed by the Foundation are summarized as follows:

a. Security Valuation

Investments in securities were valued at market price by Charles Schwab & Co.

b. Federal Taxes

The Foundation pays a 2% (or if qualified, a reduced 1%) federal excise tax on net investment income.

c. Income and Expense Recognition

Interest income and expenses are recognized on the accrual basis.

d. Undistributed Income

The Foundation is required to distribute for religious, charitable, educational and scientific purposes an amount determined in accordance with the Internal Revenue Code and Regulations. This amount must be distributed by the end of the next fiscal year of the Foundation. The amount that must be distributed by August 31, 2015 is \$0. The excess distribution carryover to August 31, 2015 is \$1,480,180.

e. Management Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

f. Income Taxes

The tax years subject to examination by the taxing authorities are the years ended August 31, 2011 and forward.

g. Subsequent Events

Management of the foundation has evaluated subsequent events through November 2, 2014 and has determined there are no subsequent events or transactions which would require recognition or disclosure in the financial statements.
