THE CITY OF AUBURN CONTRIBUTED \$5,000,000 IN-KIND INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS TO THE UNIVERSITY AS IMPROVEMENTS TO THE LAND WHERE THE AUBURN RESEARCH PARK IS LOCATED. THE BUILDING WAS COMPLETED ON OCTOBER 31, 2010. THE FOUNDATION CONTINUES TO LEASE SPACE TO BUSINESSES INVOLVED IN PROJECTS PROMOTING THE UNIVERSITY'S RESEARCH MISSION.

IN OCTOBER OF 2010, THE FOUNDATION SIGNED A LEASE WITH AUBURN UNIVERSITY FOR USE OF BUILDING 570. THE LEASE IS WORTH \$302,878, NET OF A DISCOUNT OF \$251,740. THE FOUNDATION WILL PAY \$1 ANNUALLY TO AUBURN UNIVERSITY UNDER THE LEASE - NO OTHER CONSIDERATION WILL BE GIVEN. \$22,214 OF THE LEASE WAS AMORTIZED DURING THE FISCAL YEAR 2014, WHILE \$3,939 OF THE REMAINING DISCOUNT WAS AMORTIZED AS
