ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

PIKEVILLE MEDICAL CENTER FOUNDATION FOR QUALITY HEALTHCARE, INC.

The undersigned incorporators execute these articles of incorporation for the purpose of forming and do hereby form a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, KRS 273.161 et seq., in accordance with the following provisions.

ARTICLE I. Name

The name of the corporation is Pikeville Medical Center Foundation for Quality Healthcare, Inc.

ARTICLE II. Purposes and Powers

- (A) The corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and successor provisions thereto. In carrying out its corporate purposes, the corporation shall have all the powers allowed corporations by KRS Ch. 273.
- (B) In furtherance of the general purposes in paragraph (A), the primary purpose of the corporation is to raise funds to support the operations of Pikeville Medical Center, Inc., a Kentucky non-profit corporation exempt from taxation by Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and otherwise to support the charitable and health activities of Pikeville Medical Center, Inc.

ARTICLE III. Directors

The business and affairs of the corporation shall be governed by a board of directors consisting of seven (7) persons. The board of directors of the corporation shall be elected annually by the corporation's sole member. A director of the corporation may be removed from office at any time, with or without cause, by vote of the corporation's sole member. The initial board of directors shall serve until the first annual election of directors and until their successors are elected and qualify. ARTICLE IV. Registered Office and Registered Agent

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 310 Main Street, Suite 300, Pikeville, Kentucky 41501.

The name of the initial registered agent at that address is Pamela T. May.

ARTICLE V. Principal Office

The mailing address of the principal office of the corporation is 911 Bypass Road, Pikeville, Kentucky 41501.

ARTICLE VI. Membership of Corporation

Section 6-1. - General Member

Pikeville Medical Center, Inc. shall be the sole member of this corporation, a Kentucky nonprofit nonstock corporation, hereinafter referred to as the "General Member." The General Member, and only the General Member, shall be entitled to exercise fully all rights and privileges of members of nonprofit corporations under the Kentucky Revised Statutes and all other applicable laws.

Section 6-2. - Transfer of Membership

The General Member may not transfer its membership or any rights arising therefrom.

Section 6-3. - Exercise of Membership Rights

The General Member shall exercise its membership rights through its own Board of Directors. Subject to the provisions of the General Member's Bylaws, the Board of Directors of the General Member may, by resolution, authorize a person, its executive committee, or other committee of persons to exercise its vote on any matter to come before the membership of this Corporation. In addition, and in lieu of the provision of Section 6-4 through 6-7 below, the General Member may exercise its membership rights at any regular or special meeting of the Board of Directors of the General Member.

Section 6-4. - Annual Membership Meeting

The annual meeting of the membership of the corporation shall be held at the day, hour and place as may be designated by the General Member's Board of Directors. The primary purpose of the meeting shall be the election of directors.

Section 6-5. - Special Membership Meetings

Special meetings of the members may be called by this corporation's Chair of the Board or upon the request of the General Member upon provision of notice as required in Section 6-6. A special meeting may be called for any purpose.

Section 6-6. - Notice of Membership Meetings

- (A) Notice of the annual membership meeting and special membership meetings requested by the General Member shall be given by the General Member. Written notice of the date, time and place of the meeting shall be delivered personally to this corporation's Chair of the Board.
- (B) If the annual or special membership meeting is called by the Chair of the Board the General Member shall receive not less than five (5) days prior written notice of the meeting. Written notice of the date, time and place of the meeting shall be delivered personally to the General Member. Notices shall state the purposes of the meeting.
- (C) The notice of any membership meeting at which Board of Directors are to be elected shall include the names of all those who are nominees at the time the notice is delivered or mailed.
- (D) The attendance of the General Member shall constitute a waiver of notice of the meeting, except where the General Member attends only for the express purpose of objecting to the transaction of any business because the meeting is not lawfully called or convened.

Section 6-7. - Action by Written Ballot or Consent

Any action which may be taken at any meeting of the membership may be taken without a meeting if a written ballot or request for consent is distributed to the General Member. The written ballot or request for consent shall set forth the proposed action, provide an opportunity for the General Member to specify approval or disapproval of any proposal and provide a reasonable period of time within which to return the ballot or written consent to the Corporation. Any written ballot cast or written consent delivered shall be filed with the Chairperson of the Corporation and maintained in the corporate records. Directors may be elected by written ballot or consent as herein provided.

ARTICLE VII. Officers

The bylaws shall identify and provide for the method of election or appointment of the officers of the corporation.

ARTICLE VIII. Bylaws

The bylaws of the corporation shall be adopted, and may be amended or repealed, by the board of directors of the corporation, but such actions shall be subject to the approval of corporation's sole member and no such action shall be final and valid without the approval of the sole member. Adopted bylaws cannot be amended so as to be inconsistent with these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE IX. Indemnification

Each person who is or was a member, director, trustee, or officer of the corporation, whether elected or appointed, and each person who is or was serving at the request of the corporation as a member, director, trustee, or officer of another corporation, whether elected or

appointed, including the heirs, executors, administrators, or estate of any such person, shall be indemnified by the corporation to the full amount against any liability, and the reasonable cost or expense (including attorney fees, monetary or other judgments, fines, excise taxes, or penalties and amounts paid or to be paid in settlement) incurred by such person in such person's capacity as a member, director, trustee, officer, or employee or arising out of such person's status as a member, director, trustee, officer, or employee; provided, however, no such person shall be indemnified against any such liability, cost, or expense incurred in connection with any action. suit, or proceeding in which such person shall have been adjudged liable on the basis that personal benefit was improperly received by such person, or if such indemnification would be prohibited by law. Such right of indemnification shall be a contract right and shall include the right to be paid by the corporation the reasonable expenses incurred in defending any threatened or pending action, suit, or proceeding in advance of its final disposition; provided, however, that such advance payment of expenses shall be made only after delivery to the corporation of an undertaking by or on behalf of such person to repay all amounts so advanced if it shall be determined that such person is not entitled to such indemnification. Any repeal or modification of this article shall not affect any rights or obligations then existing. If any indemnification payment required by this article is not paid by the corporation within 90 days after a written claim has been received by the corporation, the member, director, trustee, officer, or employee may at any time thereafter bring suit against the corporation to recover the unpaid amount and, if successful in whole or in part, such person shall be entitled to be paid also the expense of prosecuting such claim. The corporation may maintain insurance, at its own expense, to protect itself and any such person against any such liability, cost, or expense, whether or not the corporation would have the power to indemnify such person against such liability, cost, or expense under the Kentucky Nonprofit Corporation Acts or under this article, but it shall not be obligated to do so. The indemnification provided by this article shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights which those seeking indemnification may have or hereafter acquire under any bylaw, agreement, statute, vote of members or board of directors, or otherwise. If this article or any portion thereof shall be invalidated on any ground by any court of competent jurisdiction, then the corporation shall nevertheless indemnify each such person to the full extent permitted by any applicable portion of this article that shall not have been invalidated or by any other applicable law.

ARTICLE X. Limitation of Director Liability

No director shall be personally liable to the corporation for monetary damages for breach of his duties as a director except for liability:

- (A) For any transaction in which the director's personal financial interest is in conflict with the financial interests of the corporation;
- (B) For acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or are known to the director to be a violation of law; or
 - (C) For any transaction from which the director derives an improper personal benefit.

If the Kentucky Revised Statutes are amended after approval of this article to authorize corporate action further eliminating or limiting the personal liability of directors, then the liability of a director of the corporation shall be deemed to be eliminated or limited by this provision to the fullest extent then permitted by the Kentucky Revised Statutes, as so amended.

Any repeal or modification of this article shall not adversely affect any right or protection of a director of the corporation existing at the time of such repeal or modification.

ARTICLE XI. Amendment of Articles

The power to alter, amend or repeal these Articles of Incorporation shall be vested in and only in the General Member.

ARTICLE XII. Dissolution

Dissolution shall be accomplished in accordance with Chapter 273 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes or its successor; provided that the corporation's sole member must approve such dissolution and must also approve the plan of distribution (as provided for in KRS 273.307). Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making adequate provision for the payment of all liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all corporate assets by distributing such assets to the General Member or its successor organization, provided that the General Member or its successor is then described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. If neither General Member nor its successor organization then qualify as so described, then the assets shall be distributed to such other Section 501(c)(3) organization(s) as the Board of Directors, with the approval of the corporation's sole member, shall determine.
