THE TAX YEAR REPORTING HEREIN REPRESENTS THE PERIOD FROM SEPTEMBER 30, 2013, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 28, 2014, A 52 WEEK TAX YEAR. UNDER SECTION 441 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE CODE, THE KENNEDY CENTER MADE AN INITIAL ELECTION TO USE A 52-53 WEEK TAX YEAR IN ITS 2006 FORM 990. HOWEVER, WHEN THE INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE RESPONDED TO THE KENNEDY CENTER'S REQUEST, IT NOTIFIED THE KENNEDY CENTER THAT IT CANNOT ACCEPT A 52-53 WEEK ELECTION FOR AN EXEMPT ORGANIZATION.
