THE ORGANIZATION RECOGNIZES INTEREST AND PENALTIES, IF ANY, RELATED TO UNCERTAIN TAX POSITIONS AS INCOME TAX EXPENSE. THE ORGANIZATION'S INFORMATIONAL RETURNS ARE GENERALLY SUBJECT TO EXAMINATION FOR THREE YEARS AFTER THE LATER OF THE DUE DATE OR DATE OF FILING. AT SEPTEMBER 30, 2014, ALL TAX FILINGS FOR THE ORGANIZATION SINCE INCEPTION IN 2012 ARE AVAILABLE FOR EXAMINATION BY TAXING AUTHORITIES.
