Spanning the Idaho/Montana border, the Scotchmans are one of the last, and largest, wild areas in our region. We conduct education, outreach and stewardship activities to preserve the rugged, scenic and biologically diverse 88,000 acre Scotchman Peaks Roadless Area. We believe the Scotchman Peaks deserve congressional designation as Wilderness for the benefit and enjoyment of current and future generations.

In addition to trail maintenance activities on three ranger districts in two national forests, in the winter of 2013-2014 we partnered with Idaho Fish and Game to provide volunteer assistance in setting and checking stations as part of a rare forest carnivore wildlife study.

We have used both the trail maintenance and wildlife studies to engage students from many local schools and regional schools from the middle school, to high school and college level. We continued our Scholarship Program for high school seniors and an Essay contest in Sanders County for the Middle and High Schools.

We hosted or participated in many community events to engage the general public and our supporters alike including our annual "State of the Scotchmans" in May where we update supporters and the community on our progress and activities. In February 2014, we began a four month series of Educational Forums in Lincoln County MT examining the foundations of Community Prosperity with an eye to how conservation plays a fundamental role in a community's culture and economy.

We continued to participate in community events including the Bonner County Fair, the Huckleberry Festival in Trout Creek and 4th of July parades in Sandpoint, Clark Fork, and Noxon, MT, National Trails Day, and the Earth Day Festivals throughout the region.

We continued to present our proposal for wilderness to clubs, organizations, civic and business groups throughout the region. Our power point story has evolved and allows us to bring the audience on an "armchair
