First Financial Bank, N.A., named under the Last Will and Testament of William Howard Parks Trust, by Steven Hammer its trust officer files Petition to Modify Terms of Trust. The Court having considered such petition and being duly advised in the premises now finds:

1. That the Will and Testament of William Howard Parks, heretofore admitted to probate before this Court, created under Items Eleven and Twelve thereof the William Howard Parks Trust, which Trust is under the jurisdiction of this Court.
2. That First Financial Bank, N.A. is the duly appointed and confirmed trustee of the William Howard Parks Trust.
3. That the allegations of the Petition to Addend Terms to Trust are true and correct and that the terms of such Trust should be modified in order to further the purposes of the Trust and that the modifications proposed are in accordance with the probable intention of the testator/settlor and that such modifications are allowed under Indiana Code 30-4-3-24.4.


It is therefore CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED AS FOLLOWS:

That the following provisions are hereby ordered addended to the William Howard Parks Trust:

- Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law) or (b) by an organization contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law)

- Upon winding up and dissolution of this organization, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the organization, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a not-profit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, and or scientific purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- The organization will distribute its income for each year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- The organization will not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code
- The organization will not retain any excess business holdings as defined in section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code
- The organization will not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- The organization will not make any taxable expenditures as defined in section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code
