

This past year the MMA maintained a stable financial structure and was able to contribute significantly to retained earnings. As the Michigan economy continues its slow recovery, numerous movers were feeling the effects of reduced demand for their services. Several went out of business in 2014 but it was the unexpected number of new stores which opened that was surprising. Both MMA and MPSC staff regularly combed through Craig's List postings, writing to movers who were not part of our database, encouraging them to both join the MMA and get Alegal A with the MPSC.

We continued our tradition of financially subsidizing the annual convention, permitting smaller movers to attend at budget prices. This is the board=s way of giving back to those movers who cannot afford to attend national meetings but still need the education they offer.

Our quarterly newsletter continues to be one of the nicest in the industry and our website is an important resource for members and the public to gain information about Michigan based movers and the industry in general. We also update members through Constant Contact emails on legislative, business and industry issues.

MMA continues to be one of only three states which offers an intrastate ProMover designation. We currently have eleven Michigan movers who are certified as Michigan ProMovers.

The MMA Academic Scholarship Fund (MMA-ASF) awarded \$4,500 to nine college students this past fall and we anticipate an ever growing response to this worthwhile fund in 2015.

Our board decided to pursue a tariff rate increase this year as several years have passed without a rate increase and margins are being pinched. We were successful in garnering an 8% increase across the board which went into effect in the summer of 2014. We remain ever vigilant and watchful regarding legislation which affects the moving industry, taxation and general business issues. We are prepared to participate when necessary to protect our industry=s rights and ability to conduct business fairly and

profitably.

The MMA MoversPAC received donations which increased our fund to over \$5,000 in 2014, and we were able to contribute \$4,800 to candidates who support our position on growing Michigan=s economy and how the moving industry should be regulated.

HB 5714 (S-1) amended the Motor Carrier Act (MCA) and has been signed into law by Governor Snyder. Mr. Millenbach worked closely with MPSC staff on language, and we assisted the MPSC to attain passage of this bill prior to the end of this legislative session. This important new language modernized and clarified sections of the MCA which had become obsolete or vague.
