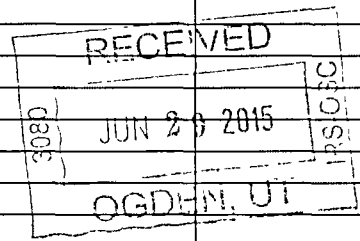

The R. A. Long Foundation has adopted the following criteria for grant-making and procedures for grant applicants:

1. a. Except for continuing grants to some of the organizations previously supported, the Foundation presently intends to restrict all future grants to organizations serving the Greater Kansas City area that are engaged in youth recreation and development, special needs of youth, or youth education. Grants to individuals will not be considered.

b. Grants for youth education will be considered at the spring meeting, and grants for youth recreation and development and youth special needs will be considered at the fall meeting. Grant deadlines are March 15 and September 15, respectively.

2. No formal application for a grant is required, and requests should be made by letter. Preferred delivery by mail or delivery. Grant requests should include or be supplemented by the following:

a. **The purpose, total amount of funding sought for the project** from the private sector, and **amount requested from R. A. Long Foundation.** Normally the Foundation does not expect to engage in ongoing program support but will consider grants for innovative programs.

b. State the **expected outcomes** for this project.

c. List any **organizations you are collaborating with** on this project.

d. **The mission and purpose or objective of the organization.**

e. **The year of founding.**

f. The **geographic area** the organization serves.

g. The name and contact information for its CEO/Executive Director.

h. A **budget** for the current year (and, if available, for the requested project or program).

i. **Financial information** for at least the past year showing, in reasonable detail, sources of funds and operating expenses and costs, **balance sheet, P/L.** An independent audit or review by a CPA can be submitted, if available.

j. A list of your **5 largest/major contributors** would be appreciated, **with amount of last gift.**

k. A list of officers and directors of the Board.

l. **State what percentage of your board makes an annual financial contribution to the organization,** and the approximate total of all annual board contributions.

m. The number of staff (full time and part time).

n. A copy of at least the first page and signature page of the most recent filed **990 tax form.**

o. Evidence that the grant seeker is not a private foundation and is a not-for-profit organization under **Section 501(c)(3)** of the Internal Revenue Code.

3. Grant applicants are not expected to expend a great deal of time in assembling the material requested above. If questions arise, they may be addressed to the Foundation prior to assembling the material. Only the original request needs to be submitted.

4. **SUPPLEMENTAL REPORTING** - The recipient of a grant shall report to the Foundation within approximately ten (10) months from the grant as to the actual use of the Foundation's funds and the results produced with this grant. **FAILURE TO DO SO MAY PRECLUDE FURTHER GRANTS.**

5. The Foundation will attempt to answer, in a preliminary fashion, whether the grant sought is likely to be considered by the Board or is beyond the scope of the current areas the Foundation supports.
