STATEMENT OF EXPLANATION FOR AMENDED RETURN

The Form 990-PF return is being amended to adjust for unrelated business income that was inadvertently included on the original 990-PF return relative to the sales of publically traded partnership (PTP) interests. Ordinary gains from sales of the PTP interests have been removed from Form 990-PF and are now reported as Unrelated Business Income on Form 990-T Form 4797. Corresponding changes have been made to the totals on Form 990-PF Part IV Line 2 and the related Part IV Schedule.

These adjustments have already been reported on the amended Form 990-T filed 10/17/16, the NOL has been adjusted to reflect these changes, and the additional tax owed has been paid.

Form 990-PF Part I Lines 7b, 12b, and 27b changed to reflect the amount reported on Part IV Line 2, and the related change in tax is included on Part VI line 1, 3, 5, 7, 8, 10, and 11.

A refund of the amount reported on Part VI line 11 of \$22,075 is requested.
