Chambers Family Fund (the Foundation) was established to provide resources to regional and national nonprofit organizations that create systems change, improve the quality and circumstances of life and reflect the founder's values and interests. Chambers Family Fund helps women become economically self-sufficient, promotes early care and education, strengthens justice, equality and opportunity, and supports the enduring contributions of Kirkland Museum of Fine & Decorative Art.

The Foundation makes a significant investment in direct charitable activities by investing time and expertise in special nonprofit initiatives. Through these activities and programs, Chambers Family Fund is proactively engaged in community planning, convening, supporting systems change, developing and expanding philanthropy, providing technical assistance for nonprofit effectiveness and the creation of new nonprofit organizations. The result is a more fully engaged approach that utilizes a combination of financial assistance, staff support, technical assistance and leadership. The primary activities are:

Ascend, an initiative of the Aspen Institute, focuses on two-generation strategies that will lift single parents and children out of poverty. In addition to its grant to the Aspen Institute, the Foundation partners with Ascend by serving on the advisory board and linking Colorado two-generation strategies and reforms to national efforts.

The Foundation's Women's Funds Initiative created and provides ongoing support to women's funds in Wyoming, Montana and Oklahoma. The Foundation also disseminates a report and provides technical assistance to create other women's funds and expand women's philanthropy throughout the country.

The Foundation staff participate in collaborative efforts and community planning to create a statewide system that ensures all children are valued, healthy and thriving in Colorado. The Foundation partnered with other foundations to create a new organization, Early Milestones Colorado, which serves as an intermediary for early childhood efforts. The Foundation provides pro bono office space for the organization.

The Foundation is constructing a new building that will house the Kirkland Museum of Fine & Decorative Art. The museum building will be held as a charitable asset of Chambers Family Fund. It is an investment in the future of Kirkland Museum as a Colorado art institution and will contribute to the further development of the Golden Triangle Museum District and the City of Denver's nationally important art scene. In 2014, Kirkland Museum had a total of 12,263 visitors from all over the world. The planning, design and construction activities are ongoing and the new Kirkland Museum of Fine & Decorative Art building is projected to open in 2017.

In 2014 total direct charitable program expenditures, including \$8,774,512 of capitalized expenditures on the new Kirkland Museum building, were \$9,002,620.
