The main focus of the committee is the conduct of Board and Committee meetings. To that extent, annual self assessments are provided for each major committee and the Board of Directors. Comments suggesting improvements or other issues relating to the operation of committees are reviewed. Statements of changes the committee plans, if any, to address or remediate the comments made are sought from the respective committees. Findings of the committee and board self assessments and resulting corrective action taken, if needed, are reported annually to the Board. In addition, an annual update from the credit union's legal counsel as to the duties and responsibilities of the board and committees is conducted.
