Reasonable Cause Statement

The Paul Simons Foundation, Inc. ("Taxpayer") is a private foundation with the principal purpose of maintaining a park and nature preserve open to the public in Stony Brook, NY.

On or about July 25, 2014, Taxpayer invested \$1,300,00.00 in Blackstone Partners Offshore Fund Ltd (the "Fund"). The Fund is managed by Blackstone Alternative Asset management L.P. ("Blackstone"), located in New York, New York. The transfer was made via wire transfer to Citibank, N.A. the Fund's administrator at the time of transfer 's. Citibank, N.A. is also located in New York, New York.

Taxpayer timely filed a Form 990-PF, Return of Private Foundation for the tax period ending June 30, 2015 ("Tax Year 2014 Form 990"). However, at the time of filing, neither the Taxpayer, nor the Taxpayer's return preparer, were aware of the requirement to file Form 926. Subsequent to filing such return, Taxpayer realized that it may have been required to attach Form 926 to its Tax Year 2014 Form 990-PF. Accordingly, Taxpayer is filing an amended Form 990 which includes a properly completed Form 926.

Form 926 is required to be filed when taxpayers engage in certain transactions with foreign entities. See IRC § 6038B; Treas. Reg. § §1.6038B-1. The tax code imposes a penalty for the failure to furnish Form 926, however, such penalty "shall not apply to any failure if [the taxpayer] shows such failure is due to reasonable cause and not to willful neglect." IRC § 6038B(c). Here, Taxpayer can clearly show that it had reasonable cause and that its failure to file Form 926 was not due to willful neglect.

First, it was not readily apparent that Taxpayer transferred funds overseas. The Fund is managed by Blackstone in its New York office. Accordingly, communications between Taxpayer and Blackstone occurred between two domestic Parties. Additionally, when the fund transfer was made, Taxpayer was not fully aware that it was transferring funds to a foreign entity. The wire transfer was made via Citibank, N.A. which is another New York institution. Pursuant to the regulations, "reasonable cause and good faith" is evidenced by "an honest misunderstanding of fact or law that is reasonable in light of all of the facts and circumstances, including the experience, knowledge, and education of the taxpayer." Here, neither the Taxpayer nor its employees have extensive experience or knowledge about financial investing. Taxpayer relied on Blackstone to place it into reasonable and appropriate investment options. At the time the investment was made, Taxpayer was not aware that it was entering into a transnational investment. Accordingly, Taxpayer has reasonable cause for its failure to file Form 926 based upon its misunderstanding of the underlying facts of the matter.

Second, Taxpayer relied on its tax preparer in good faith to accurately complete its annual tax return. The Treasury regulations provide that "[r]eliance on . . . professional advice . . . constitutes reasonable cause and good faith if, under all the circumstances, such reliance was reasonable and the taxpayer acted in good faith." Treas. Reg. § 1.6664-4(b)(1). In this matter, Taxpayer provided its tax preparer with all relevant documentation and disclosed all relevant information necessary to prepare its Tax Year 2014 Form 990. Moreover, Taxpayer does not employ individuals with expertise in international taxation. Thus Taxpayer reasonably relied in good faith on the conclusions of its tax preparer in not filing Form 926. See Treas. Reg. § 1.6664-4(c)(1) (the taxpayer's education, sophistication and business experience will be relevant in determining whether the taxpayer's reliance on tax advice was reasonable and made in good faith.").

This matter is also highly distinguishable from *United States v. Boyle*, 469 U.S 241 (1985), which held that a taxpayer has a non-delegable duty to timely file returns. In *Boyle*, the Court noted that "[i]t requires no special training or effort to ascertain a deadline and make sure that it is met." *Id.* at 252. This matter does not involve a failure to ascertain a deadline. Rather, IRC § 6038B(a)(1)(A) requires taxpayers to know whether a transfer of property is "an exchange described in section 332, 351, 354, 355, 356, or 361..." Deciphering such statutory commands clearly requires both special training and experience in the esoteric framework of international corporate tax law. Many tax practitioners focused primarily on domestic or non-corporate tax issues may have difficulties navigating these rules. The average taxpayer cannot be expected to master the intricacies of IRC § 6038B, thus Taxpayer's reliance on the assistance of a professional tax preparer was eminently reasonable.

Additionally, the required forms for private foundations do not give taxpayers notice that a Form 926 may be required. Private foundations filing Form 990-PF, as opposed to public charities filing Form 990, are not required to file a Schedule F. Compare Instructions to Form 990-PF with Instructions for Form 990. Preparing a Schedule F to Form 990 would have alerted the Taxpayer to the potential requirement to file Form 926. See Schedule F (Form 990) 2014, Part IV, line 1 ("Was the organization a U.S. transferor of property to a foreign corporation during the tax year? If 'Yes,' the organization may be required to file Form 926"). However, Schedule F is not an attachment to Form-990-PF, thus Taxpayer was not alerted to the possibility that its activities could result in a Form 926 filing requirement. Accordingly, Taxpayer was not on notice that a Form 926 may have been required and its failure to file such form was reasonable given the circumstances.

Last, assessing a penalty under IRC § 6038B(c) would result in a tremendous hardship for the Taxpayer. Taxpayer is a private foundation solely focused on maintaining a park and nature preserve for the benefit of the public and it does not have unlimited funds achieve this purpose. Assessment of a penalty in this situation would serve no public purpose because Taxpayer is voluntarily amending its tax return to provide the required disclosures. Yet, assessment of the penalty would threaten the local community's ability to enjoy the public park maintained with Taxpayer's assets.

As demonstrated above, reasonable cause exists to abate the IRC § 6038B(c) penalty. Penalties exist to encourage voluntary compliance with the tax laws and should generally be proportionate to the infraction they are meant to correct. Here, Taxpayer made a minor error by failing to file an information return and has voluntarily come forward to correct this error. Accordingly, we respectfully request that no IRC § 6038B(c) penalty be assessed in this matter.
