Rupununi Learners Foundation (RLF) is a US based 501 (c) (3) which exists to provide financial, strategic planning and development support to

Rupununi Learners Inc. (RLI) a Guyana-Based NGO with a Board composed of Yupukari Village, GY residents.

The Purpose of RLI:

- 1) To own and manage the tangible assets (facilities) of Caiman House Field Station (CHFS) thereby providing critical village-based employment to the region and fiscal support to RLI programming; and
- 2) To fulfill a mission of strengthening regional education primarily literacy, natural resource study and sustainable development planning, and indigenous knowledge preservation in Yupukari and surrounding villages.

RLI Programming

Community & School Libraries and Related Literacy Programming

RLF/RLI Mission This is core to the joint RLF/RLI mission. RLF overseas the assets and operations of an internet and laptop-equipped public library as well as supplying village school libraries. The Yupukari Public Library (RPL) serves as a base of operations. The YPL is open 7days/week, employs I full-time and I part-time village- based librarian,, multiple trainees, and frequently benefits from additional resources such as visiting volunteers. YPL measure the impact of its various programming efforts in several ways: including the pass-rate of students on the standardized high-school entrance exam, self reported and observational population usuage of YPL resources, and village literacy rates. From a base rate of 0 primary school graduates in 2004, Yupukari has been receiving a better than 50% admission rate to high school since 2010.

Natural Resource Research & Education

Internationally recognized tagging and tracking research on the Black Caiman, largest of the aliigator species: this research activity draws significant eco-tourism to CHFS. RLI also supports an award-winning Youth Wildlife Club: jaguar, wild bird, and [now in its third year] turtle research and preservation, co-supported by Linton/Exmoor Zoo (UK) and Phoenix Zoo (USA) who fund directly to RLI in Guyana. 2014 saw the addition of a Yale University post-doctoral Principal Investigator to the Caiman Project, building new skills among the indigenous crew and adding new metrics to our body of Caiman data.

Indigenous Knowledge (IK) and Cross-Cultural Education - Program Development

In development since late 2008, GLASS (Guyana Lesley Abroad Service Semester) is a 12 credit, full semester, Study Abroad program, designed by Rupununi Learners in partnership with Lesley University (Cambridge, MA). The Glass business plan won the 2009 Social Enterprise and Innovation Competition at Washington University in St. Louis, and in 2010 Lesley University accredited the program. In 2014, four Lesley students, one regular Lesley faculty and 2 Lesley adjuncts participated. This program servies a variery of ongoing mission centric purposes: drawing long-tern paying guests to our Guest House and ancillary eco-tourism revenue streams, providing new village-based employment for residents as Indigenous Knowledge(IK) teachers, providing new income streams for RLI team members who fill staff and adjunct roles through Lesley, and preserving the traditional IK of this exceptionally diverse and unspoiled region.
