#### ARTICLE I

#### **Officers**

The officers of the corporation shall consist of a President, one or more Vice Presidents, a Treasurer, an Assistant Treasurer, and a Secretary. Each shall be a member of the Board of Directors.

The Board of Directors may appoint such other officers as it may deem necessary and shall appoint an Executive Director as the chief operating officer of the corporation, who shall not be a member of the Board of Directors. Unless removed, all officers shall hold office until their successors are elected.

#### **ARTICLE II**

#### **Directors**

<u>Section 1</u>. The general management of the affairs of the corporation shall be vested in a board of seven (7) directors. Directors shall be volunteers and serve without compensation.

Section 2. Directors shall be elected annually for a term of one (1) year by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the entire Board of Directors. Each elected director shall hold office until his or her successor is duly elected and qualified. Each director shall be not older than 80, shall be a domiciliary of Southern Chautauqua County, and shall actually reside in this geographic area at least six (6) months of the year. Each duly elected and serving director shall, upon reaching the age of 80, be designated a *Director Emeritus* for such period of time as he or she shall thereafter be willing to serve the corporation. A Director Emeritus shall be entitled to attend board meetings, offer advice on matters coming before the Board, and receive copies of minutes, agendas, and such other written materials as are presented for Board consideration. A Director Emeritus shall not be an officer of the corporation and shall not be entitled to vote. A Director Emeritus shall be permitted to designate discretionary grants under the same policy as is applicable from time to time to the directors of the corporation.

Section 3. Any director may be removed at any time by a vote of all other duly elected directors at a regular meeting of the Board of Directors or at a special meeting of the Board called for that purpose. No director, however, shall be removed at any meeting unless at least five (5) days prior to the date thereof notice of the time, place, and purpose of such meeting shall have been served upon the director whose removal is sought at said meeting or shall have been deposited in the mail directed to the director at the director's last known address appearing upon the books of the corporation. Notice of a meeting at which the removal of a director is to be voted upon shall be served by mail by the Secretary whenever so directed in writing by three (3) directors over their own signatures.

<u>Section 4.</u> The annual meeting of the corporation shall be held in January of each year. The Directors shall hold regular meetings for the transaction of business at least once per calendar quarter.

- <u>Section 5</u>. The President may schedule additional meetings, or may call special meetings by giving prior written notice to the Board of Directors and shall call a special meeting of the Board of Directors whenever requested in writing so to do by at least two (2) directors. Written notice, or writing, shall include any form of written communication authorized under the New York Not-for-Profit Corporation Law.
- <u>Section 6.</u> Officers of the corporation shall be elected annually at the January annual meeting of the Board to serve until the next annual meeting, unless sooner removed by the Board of Directors.
- Section 7. Any one or more members of the Board of Directors may participate in a meeting of the Board by means of a conference telephone, video conference, or similar equipment that allows all persons participating in the meeting to hear each other at the same time. Participation by such means shall constitute presence in person at such meeting. A meeting of the Board of Directors may be held outside the State of New York upon written consent of all members of the Board of Directors. Directors are expected to attend all regular meetings of the Board.
- <u>Section 8.</u> When an action requires a vote in between meetings, voting members may consent to take the action without holding a meeting. This consent must be unanimous. Consent may be made via any means authorized under the New York Not-for-Profit Corporation Law.

#### **ARTICLE III**

#### **Powers of Directors**

- Section 1. The Board of Directors shall have general charge and supervision of all the affairs of the corporation; shall hire and discharge all agents and employees and fix their salaries; shall authorize all contracts, donations, and gifts and shall specify the terms and conditions upon which gifts and contributions shall be made, provided such terms and conditions shall in no way contravene the terms and provisions upon which any gift or donation shall have been made to this corporation; and shall fill all vacancies of officers or directors occasioned by death, resignation, removal, or otherwise and may remove from office, with or without cause, any person holding an office, other than the President, including a member of the Board of Directors.
- <u>Section 2</u>. Except as herein otherwise provided, four (4) members shall constitute a quorum, though a smaller number may adjourn any meeting at which no quorum is present to a later day.
- Section 3. If a director or officer of the corporation is made a party to any civil or criminal action or proceeding in any matter arising from the performance by such director or officer of his or her duties for or on behalf of the corporation, then, to the full extent permitted by law, the corporation, upon affirmative vote of the Board of Directors, a quorum of directors being present at the time of the vote who are not parties to the action or proceeding, shall:
  - (1) Advance to such director or officer all sums found by the Board of Directors, so voting, to be necessary and appropriate to enable the director or officer to conduct his or her defense or appeal in the action or proceeding; and
  - (2) Indemnify such director or officer for all sums paid by him or her in the way of judgments, fines, amounts paid in settlement, and reasonable expenses, including attorney's fees, actually and necessarily incurred in connection with the action or proceeding or appeal therein, subject to the proper application of credit for any sums advanced to the director or officer pursuant to clause (1) of this paragraph.

#### ARTICLE IV

#### President

The President shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors of the corporation at which he or she shall be present. The President shall appoint all committees unless otherwise ordered by resolution of the Board of Directors and shall *ex officio* be a member of all committees. The President shall sign for the corporation all deeds and other agreements and formal instruments.

In the absence or disability of the President, the Board of Directors may appoint one of their members to discharge such of the President's functions as may be assigned to such appointee.

#### Vice President

In the absence or incapacity of the President, the senior Vice President shall perform the duties of the President and, when so acting, shall have all the powers of and be subject to all the restrictions upon the President. Each Vice President shall perform any other duties as may be assigned by the President or by the Board of Directors.

#### **ARTICLE V**

#### **Treasurer**

The Treasurer shall keep or provide for correct and complete records of account, showing accurately at all times the financial condition of the Foundation. The Treasurer shall be the legal custodian of all monies, notes, securities, non-cash assets and other valuables that may from time to time come into the possession of the Foundation and shall periodically review accounting procedures for said items. The Treasurer shall periodically review the procedures for the deposit of all monies in the name of the Foundation in such banks, investment companies and other depositories as shall be selected by the Board of Directors. The Treasurer shall review monthly bank/investment statements, balance sheets and other financial reports. The Treasurer may be authorized by the Board as a dual check signer when a check exceeds the amount the Board has approved for the Executive Director's sole signature. The Treasurer shall furnish, or cause to be furnished, at meetings of the Directors, or whenever requested, a statement of the financial conditions of the Foundation, and shall perform such other duties as the Bylaws may provide or the Directors may prescribe. The Treasurer shall furnish, or cause to be furnished, full and accurate reports of receipts and disbursements to the Board of Directors at the Annual Meeting. The Treasurer reviews the annual audit and tax filings.

#### **Assistant Treasurer**

In the absence or incapacity of the Treasurer, the Assistant Treasurer shall perform the duties of the Treasurer and, when so acting, shall have all the powers of and be subject to all the restrictions upon the Treasurer. The Assistant Treasurer shall perform any other duties as may be assigned by the Board of Directors.

#### **ARTICLE VI**

#### Secretary

The Secretary shall send out all notices of meetings of the Board of Directors and shall attend all meetings and keep accurate minutes of proceedings at such meetings. The Secretary shall have the custody of the corporate seal, shall conduct the correspondence of the corporation, and shall attend to such other duties as may be assigned to him or her.

The corporation shall keep accurate and complete books and records of account and shall also keep minutes of the proceedings of the Board of Directors and committees having any authority of the Board of Directors.

#### **ARTICLE VII**

#### **Funds of the Corporation**

All funds of the corporation shall be deposited in such banks, investment companies or other depositories as may from time to time be designated by the Board of Directors. Deposits of funds shall be made subject to draft only on the signatures of the Executive Director and one of such officers of the corporation as shall be designated for such purpose by resolution of the Board of Directors.

No part of the principal of the funds of the corporation shall be distributed except pursuant to a resolution passed by the affirmative vote of four (4) members of the Board of Directors; provided, however, that the Executive Director shall have authority to pay bills for the ordinary and necessary operating expenses of the corporation, to execute drafts solely upon the signature of the Executive Director in amounts not exceeding \$5,000, and to approve small grants to qualified applicants in such amounts as shall be approved under guidelines established by resolution of the Board of Directors.

#### **ARTICLE VIII**

#### **Audit Committee**

At the beginning of each fiscal year, the President shall appoint an Audit Committee, consisting of 2 or more directors, who will be responsible for the following tasks:

- Prior to the audit, reviewing the scope and planning of the audit with the auditor.
- Following the audit, reviewing with the auditor any material risks or weaknesses identified, any restrictions on the scope of the auditor's activities, any significant disagreements between the auditor and management, and the adequacy of the corporation's accounting and financial processes.
- Annually, consider and report to the board the auditor's performance and independence.

#### **ARTICLE IX**

#### **Executive Director**

The day-to-day operation of the corporation shall be under the direction and control of an Executive Director, who shall be an employee of the corporation and appointed by a majority vote of the entire Board of Directors. The Executive Director shall be charged with carrying out the resolutions, policies, and directives adopted by the Board of Directors from time to time and shall be responsible for supervision of all other employees of the corporation.

#### **ARTICLE X**

#### **Notices**

All notices required by these bylaws or otherwise shall be in writing and shall be either personally delivered, mailed, e-mailed, or faxed to the directors of the corporation at their addresses (physical or virtual) as entered in the office of the Secretary of the corporation. Any notice required by these bylaws or otherwise may be waived, in writing.

#### ARTICLE XI

#### Seal

The seal of this corporation shall be circular in design and shall have on the outer edge the name "RALPH C. SHELDON FOUNDATION, INC.," and in the inner circle the words "Corporate Seal, 1948, New York," a facsimile of which is impressed on the outer edge hereof.

#### **ARTICLE XII**

#### **Dissolution**

In the event of liquidation or dissolution of the corporation, whether voluntary or involuntary, after payment of all debts and liabilities of the corporation of whatsoever kind or nature, its remaining funds and other property and rights, including all rights of the corporation to receive future distributions from the Isabella M. Sheldon Trust, shall be transferred to the Chautauqua Region Community Foundation, or any successor public charity thereto, (or such other public charity then designated by a majority vote of the entire board of directors) upon the required condition that the receiving public charity maintain all assets so received in an endowed fund named in honor of the Ralph and Isabella Sheldon family and agree to thereafter, from time to time and at the sole discretion of the public charity, distribute grants therefrom only to organizations with significant activities in Chautauqua County, NY, which are exempt from taxation under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or any other successor section. If the transfer of assets and rights under the above conditions fails, the New York Supreme Court, Eighth Judicial District, shall select such organization or organizations and define the appropriate conditions.

#### **ARTICLE XIII**

#### **Amendments**

These bylaws may be amended only upon a majority vote of the entire Board of Directors at any meeting duly called for that purpose or any regular meeting of the Board of Directors, provided a written notice has been sent to each member of the Board of Directors at least five (5) days in advance of the date of the meeting stating specifically the proposed amendment.
