The program also assists with personal safety, an issue that NAA is devoted to feel individuals with autism and their families. NAA distributed its Big Red Safety Boxes containing materials to help prevent dangero wandering and elopement incidents to over 5100 families across the US at no charge. NAA provided safety training to caregivers, social workers and first responders. NAA also offered information and support through its website, toll-free line and its four day National Autism Conférence featuring renowned experts.
