


Money was raised through donations in order to secure legal title to the land as determined by the Haitian justice system. Settlement was reached for \$ 250,000, with the remaining costs consisting of title registration, legal fees, and other transaction costs in-country.  
As a result of this accomplishment the orphanage and school we support, owned by Souls Winning Ministries (Haiti) was able to continue its more than 10 year tradition of caring for orphans and providing a quality education.
