- Minimum of one year of financial data, and IRS tax return for a 12-month period prior to application
- Organizations must file an IRS 990 or 990-EZ. Organizations that file an IRS 990N are not eligible.
- No government agencies (local, county, state or federal)
- Organization must primarily benefit animals (not people) in the United States and operate only in the United States.
- Must have 12 months of service to animals excluding fundraising.
- All animals must be spayed/neutered/castrated prior to adoption.
- Many types of organizations (humane societies, rescue groups, low-cost spay/neuter clinics, wildlife, sanctuaries, etc.) receive funding; however, sanctuaries which do not own their land and facility will not be considered.
