PART IX-A

To date, over \$17,000,000 has been invested in the purchase and renovations of the buildings to be used by the Legacy Charter School. This started in 2010 with the purchase of the Parker High campus for grades 5 through 9. Within the next year, the Fine Arts Center was purchased and renovated to house grades K5 through 4. In October of 2012 the total enrollment was 788. Grades K5-4 had 426, grades 5 through 8 had 264 and the high school grades 9 through 11 had 98. The school added a senior class in the 2013-14 academic years. In 2012 the Campbell Young Leaders Foundation also purchased an additional property located at 521 E. Bramlett Road to be used as a preschool at a future date. Currently, plans for this are being developed. In 2013, 5 properties were purchased by Campbell Young Leaders and are being used for athletic student training. The facility is also available for parent and community use.

The Legacy Charter School educational programs are crafted to encourage eager minds and to grow healthy bodies with the mission as a college preparatory school beginning with kindergarten. Classes are small which affords a close student/teacher relationship. Critical thinking and reasoning skills are emphasized. The Legacy Charter School means to assure good student health by requiring a five day, 45-minute PE class for all students, and independent consultants have designed model menus offering nutritional and appetizing meals attractively served. This program is measured by Furman University's exercise and science professor, Dr. Julian Reed.

The Campbell Young Leaders Foundation, in conjunction with Legacy Charter School's Board of Trustees, assists in raising support from persons, corporations, and foundations to do the following:

1. A new entrance with a lighted walkway was added to the Middle/High School Campus gymnasium with modifications for a spacious lobby, ticket booth, concession stand and sports shop. Also, public restrooms and an HVAC system were added for this facility.
2. The gymnasium locker rooms were redesigned and rebuilt. Foldout spectator seating on the gym floor was added.
3. The athletic field was rebuilt with artificial turf and lighting, a new outdoor basketball court and a walking track.
4. The first and second floors of the Middle/High School building are being renovated, including HVAC, new windows, new lighting, new floor coverings, etc. This includes the Arts wing renovations, complete with a new roof.
5. The second floor of the Heritage Building is being redesigned as a media center/library. A three-story elevator tower will be added. Additionally, the media center and classroom building will be connected. The first floor of the Heritage Building will include redesign of the school cafeteria and kitchen. New heating and air conditioning will be completed to serve both floors of the Heritage Building. Windows, roof, and HVAC will be replaced.
6. Plans are to make the second floor of the vocational building into a large meeting room which will be used for school classes and community functions. This renovation will include new restroom facilities, windows, and HVAC. An elevator entrance will be constructed on the school side of the building.
7. A new Library / Media Center is being designed at the Legacy Elementary site.
