DOYLESTOWN AREA FISH NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS DECEMBER 31, 2014

NOTE 1-SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES AND SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Doylestown Area FISH (FISH) is a non-profit organization which was established in February 1996 by the Central Bucks Christian Council in response to the community's needs. FISH provides assistance to individuals for emergency needs including shelter, food, and transportation.

INCOME TAXES

FISH is exempt from Federal income tax as an organization described in Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The financial statements of FISH have been prepared using the cash basis of accounting. Under this method, revenue is recognized when received rather than when earned, and expenses are recognized when paid rather than when the related obligation is incurred.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT PRESENTATION

FISH reports information regarding its financial position and activities according to three classes of net assets: unrestricted net assets, temporarily restricted net assets, and permanently restricted net assets.

CONCENTRATION RISK

Revenues are primarily from residents, businesses, and government agencies of Bucks County Pennsylvania.

CONTRIBUTIONS

Contributions received are recorded as unrestricted, temporarily restricted, or permanently restricted net assets depending on the existence or nature of any donor restrictions. FISH did not have any temporarily restricted net assets at December 31, 2014.

ESTIMATES

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

CONTRIBUTED SERVICES AND FACILITIES

During the year ended December 31, 2014 FISH received donated services from volunteers. These donated services constitute a significant factor in the operation of the organization but, due to their nature and lack of objective means of evaluation, they are not recorded as contributions.

CASH AND CASH EQUIVALENTS

For purposes of the statement of cash flows, Friends considers all highly liquid investments with an initial maturity of three months or less to be cash equivalents.

NOTE 2-EVALUATION OF SUBSEQUENT EVENTS

FISH has evaluated subsequent events through May 14, 2015, the date which the financial statements were available to be issued.

NOTE 3-ENDOWMENT FUND

FISH has permanently restricted funds from donors in the amount of \$10,000. The earnings are used by the Organization for charitable purposes. Funds are invested with the Bucks County Foundation. (See Note 4)

NOTE 4-INVESTMENT ACCOUNT

The Organization has an investment account with the Bucks County Foundation. PNC Institutional Investments handles the account for the Foundation. Total investment cost by the organization through 2014 is \$80,356. \$10,000 is permanently restricted as discussed in Note 3. Income is reinvested and the balance in the account was \$109,083 at December 31, 2014.
