However, normal expenditures that keep property in its ordinarily efficient operating condition are deducted as ordinary and necessary business expenses. Capitalization Criteria: The taxpayer analyzes the facts and circumstances to determine whether an expenditure should be capitalized. For instance, expenditures for assets with a useful life greater than one year are typically capitalized. Materials and Supplies: The cost of materials and supplies is currently deducted in the year paid or incurred. Acquisition Costs: Amounts paid in connection with the acquisition of an asset generally are capitalized as part of the new fixed asset. These costs are deducted if the asset is not actually acquired.
