To date, 456 projects have taken place in 40 states of the U.S., serving 503 widows, helping 509 orphans become adopted, and raising funds for orphanages around the world. Each project starts with a team of volunteers who work on a widow's house, primarily doing light repair, painting, cleaning and landscaping. The team of volunteers also sends out letters requesting sponsorship for their workday - the money raised through sponsorship goes 100% towards adoption funding and orphan care.
