Part 1, Line 2: As part of our Volunteer Program, we visit school sites twice a year to evaluate those needing classrooms, more
support for disadvantaged students to be able to go to school and more support to ensure that students are receiving a
quality education. Direct observations of existing and in-process projects are made in order to ensure that goals and
objectives for the expansion of quality educational opportunities in Niger are being met. Initially, our partner
organization, the Evangelical Church of Niger requests support for a project with specific goals and objectives. In the
case of capital projects, local leaders must meet certain criteria before support is mobilized and transferred. First, they
must begin by starting a kindergarten and obtaining official recognition and accreditation from the Nigerien
government. Next, we create, discuss and sign a memorandum of understanding for the construction of each school
building and the development of each school site, which includes the number and amounts of funds that will be
transferred, the monitoring and evaluation process and clear expectations and responsibilities for our organizations. We
transfer the funds to the Evangelical Church of Niger Education Department Ecobank account as directed in the
memorandum of understanding. With regards to the Student Sponsorship Program, the process is similar. The school
board and director send us the names and photos of students who meet certain criteria, which is primarily dependent
on the families' low-income economic status. In other words, they are unable to afford to send their child to school.
During our visits to Niger, we take updated photos of the students in the program and they make an art project and/ or
write a letter to their sponsor. In addition to visiting the school sites twice a year, we communicate by phone and email
weekly with our partners, who send us notice of receipt of funds, photos of projects and programs and reports. We
maintain complete and accurate records documenting the process and results of our programs and projects. Currently,
the Evangelical Church of Niger is our only partner. The Evangelical Church of Niger received its official non-
governmental organization status by the Nigerien government over forty years ago.
