STATEMENT

THEREFORE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE INSTRUCTIONS, THE TAXPAYER FILED A FORM 990-PF AND PAID THE EXCISE TAX DUE. UPON FURTHER REVIEW, THE TAXPAYER DETERMINED THAT IT WOULD MEET THE PUBLIC SUPPORT REQUIREMENTS OF 509(A)(2), AND AS A RESULT THE TAXPAYER HAS FILED A FORM 8940 REQUESTING RETROACTIVE RECLASSIFICATION TO A PUBLIC CHARITY BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2014. THE TAXPAYER HAS ALSO FILED A FORM 990, RETURN OF ORGANIZATION EXEMPT FROM INCOME TAX, FOR ITS TAX YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2014 WITH THE IRS OGDEN, UT SERVICE CENTER.
