Part III: What is the organization's primary exempt purpose: The organization's mission is to build education capacity in rural Haiti through a
integrated community-based model comprised of an academic enrichment program, community learning center with a library and computer
lab, and student scholarships.
28. In 2014, the organization established a computer lab with solar power and 10 computer stations in the community library. This facility
provides the only public access to computers in the region. It affords the community of 40,000 people and 10,000 school-aged students
access to computer training and the world of global learning. In addition, the organization purchased more than 300 books in French, Kreyo
and English, national exam assessment materials, and innovative educational resources for the library. This year, approximately 500 studen
and community members accessed the library and computer lab each month. In addition, area teachers and community leaders attended a
24-hour comprehensive computer training course.
29. In 2014, the organization's academic enrichment program provided a summer camp and an after-school interscholastic academic
competition for area students. Approximately 2500 students from 11 area schools benefited from these programs. The summer enrichment
camp, for over 100 students, included instruction in basic reading and math, basic computer literacy, English, arts and crafts, and athletics.
Lunch and potable water were provided. U.S. professionals trained local teachers in new pedagogical methods during the program.
Interactive classroom materials, supplies, books, computers, software, and athletic equipment were also provided. These materials were
donated to local schools and the community library after the program concluded. The academic competition, involving all students from 11
area schools, provided weekly contests based on the Haitian national curriculum. Students competed for placement on school teams and
then schools competed against each other. The principals' organization, CANEV, supervised the weekly contests and distributed study
materials. This competition has had demonstrable results, raising area passing rates on national exams by as much as 10-30% at
participating schools.
30. In 2014, the organization provided full or partial tuition scholarships for 220 students from thirteen area schools. These scholarships
covered tuition, books, school supplies and uniforms, as needed, for each of these students.
