The amount of support received by Duquesne University is sufficient to ensure the attentiveness of Duquesne University to the operations of the Elizabeth K Wingerter Charitable Foundation. Although the annual distribution to Duquesne University and its School of Education does not constitute 50% of its income for endowed scholarship purposes in the School of Education, it is respectfully submitted that in order to avoid interruption of carrying on and satisfying the purposes of the Elizabeth K. Wingerter Scholarship Fund, Duquesne University and its School of Education will be sufficiently attentive to the operations of this Charitable Foundation. This is the case where both the Elizabeth K Wingerter Charitable Foundation and Duquesne University and its School of Education earmark the support received from this Charitable Foundation for purposes of the Elizabeth K. Wingerter Scholarship in the School of Education at Duquesne University Without the continued support of the Elizabeth K. Wingerter Charitable Foundation, Duquesne University and its School of Education might not continue to maintain the Scholarship Fund established by Elizabeth K. Wingerter and Duquesne University and called the Elizabeth K. Wingerter Scholarship Fund Thus, the Elizabeth K. Wingerter Charitable Foundation will be treated as providing Duquesne University and its School of Education with a sufficient portion of the University's total support to ensure its attentiveness to the operations of the Elizabeth K. Wingerter Charitable Foundation.
