#### AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF NORTHFIELD SHARES

Pursuant to the provisions of the Minnesota Nonprofit Corporation Act, Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 317A, Northfield Area Foundation has adopted certain amendments to its Articles of Incorporation. The following Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation incorporate all such amendments and restate, supersede, and take the place of all existing Articles of Incorporation of Northfield Area Foundation.

#### ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this corporation is Northfield Shares.

#### ARTICLE II PURPOSES AND POWERS

- (a) Northfield Shares is a corporation organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes as permitted by the Minnesota Nonprofit Corporation Act.
- (b) In the event that the Board of Directors of this corporation determines that this corporation shall seek tax-exempt status as an entity described in Section 50l(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Code"), this corporation shall be organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of, and, as contemplated and permitted by, Sections 170(c)(2) and 50l(c)(3) of the Code. At any time during which this provision is in effect, the principal purposes and functions of the corporation recited in (a) above shall be conducted and carried out within the limitations of this paragraph.
- (c) Within the framework and limitations of the foregoing, this organization shall be operated exclusively to engage in, advance, support, promote, and administer charitable activities, causes, and projects of every kind and nature whatsoever in its own behalf, or as agent, trustee, or representative of others, and, to the extent consistent with the foregoing purposes, to aid, assist, and contribute to the support of corporations, associations, trusts, foundations, and institutions (1) that are organized and operated exclusively for one or more purposes described in Sections 170(c)(2) and 501(c)(3) of the Code, (2)-that are described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, and (3) that are exempt from federal income taxes under Section 501(a) of the Code. For such purposes, and not otherwise, this corporation shall have and may exercise all powers that are afforded to this corporation by the Minnesota Nonprofit Corporation Act; provided, however, upon seeking tax-exempt status as aforesaid, this corporation shall not carry on any activity, pursue any purpose, or exercise any power not permitted to be carried on, pursued or exercised by a corporation that is exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(a) of

the Code as an organization described in Section 501(c)(4) of the Code (if tax-exempt status is sought under paragraph (c) above), or in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or by a corporation that is described in, and contributions to which are deductible for federal income tax purposes under, Section 170(c)(2) of the Code (if tax-exempt status is sought under paragraph (b) above).

All references in these Articles of Incorporation to a particular section of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 shall mean and include, as now enacted or as hereafter amended, such section and any provision of federal law as is or may hereafter be applicable cognate to such section. All references in these Articles of Incorporation to the Minnesota Nonprofit Corporation Act shall mean and include, as now enacted or as hereafter amended, Chapter 317A of the Minnesota Statutes and any provision of Minnesota law as is or may hereafter be applicable cognate to such chapter.

## ARTICLE III MEMBERS

This corporation shall not have any members.

## ARTICLE IV BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The management and direction of the business and affairs of this corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors. The number, qualifications, terms of office, method of selection or election, powers, authority, and duties of the directors of this corporation, the time and place of their meetings, and such other provisions with respect to them as are not inconsistent with the express provisions of these Articles of Incorporation shall be as specified in or prescribed pursuant to the Bylaws of this corporation.

## ARTICLE V NO PERSONAL LIABILITY

The officers and directors of this corporation shall not be personally liable to any extent whatsoever for any debts or obligations of this corporation.

#### ARTICLE VI REGISTERED OFFICE

The registered office of this corporation shall be 19 Bridge Square, Northfield, Minnesota, 55057, Rice County, State of Minnesota.

#### ARTICLE VII PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

No part of the net income or earnings of this corporation shall, directly or indirectly, inure to the benefit of any officer, director, or other person having a personal and private interest in the activities of the corporation, but this corporation may pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to this corporation in furtherance of its purposes set forth in Article II hereof. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation, and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office. Except as permitted by applicable law, this corporation shall not lend money to, or guarantee the obligation of, any director or officer of this corporation.

## ARTICLE VIII DISSOLUTION

This corporation may be dissolved in accordance with the laws of the State of Minnesota. Upon dissolution of this corporation, and after the payment of all liabilities and obligations of this corporation and all costs and expenses incurred by this corporation in connection with such dissolution, any or all remaining assets shall be distributed to one or more other charitable organizations, provided that the recipients are then exempt from federal income taxes under 501(a) of the Code, and are organized and operated exclusively for one or more purposes described in Sections 170(c)(2) and 501(c)(3) of the Code and are described in Section 509(a)(1), (2), or (3) of the Code, in such proportions as shall be determined by the Board of Directors of this corporation, only if required by laws of the State of Minnesota then in existence that a court of competent jurisdiction conduct the dissolution, by such court.

## ARTICLE IX ADOPTION AND AMENDMENT OF BYLAWS

The initial Bylaws of the corporation may be adopted by the incorporator or by the initial Board of Directors; thereafter, the power to adopt, amend, revise, and repeal the Bylaws and these Articles of Incorporation shall be as set forth in the Bylaws of the corporation.

## ARTICLE X WRITTEN ACTION BY DIRECTORS

Any action that may be taken at a meeting of the Board or of any committee may be taken without a meeting if authorized in a written action signed, or consented to in an authenticated electronic communication, or in one or more counterparts, by the number of directors or committee members that would be required to take the same action at a meeting of the Board or such committee, as the case may be, at which all of the Board or committee members were present.

# ARTICLE XI DURATION

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE XII CAPITAL STOCK

The corporation shall not have capital stock.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the officers of this corporation are, and each acting alone is, authorized to do and perform any and all such acts, including execution of any and all documents and certificates as such officers shall deem necessary or advisable to carry out the purpose and intent of the foregoing resolution;

FINALLY, BE IT RESOLVED, that any actions taken by such officers prior to the date of the foregoing resolutions being adopted are now ratified, confirmed, and approved as the acts and deeds of this corporation.
