The undersigned, being the Trustees of The Lee Merrick Foundation, Inc. (the "Company"), do hereby consent in writing to the following resolution pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 181.0821 and Article Six, Section 9 of the Bylaws of the Company, with full force and effect as if approved at a meeting of the Trustees, duly noticed and held in accordance with the Bylaws of the Company.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, Wis. Stat. § 181.1001 provides that the Company may amend its Articles of Incorporation, Article Nine of the Bylaws of the Company provides that the Board of Trustees may amend the Bylaws; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees wishes to amend the purposes of the Company,

NOW, THEREFORE, based on the foregoing, it is hereby:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees shall cause the Articles of Incorporation of the Company to be amended as follows. Article III, paragraph 1, shall be amended to provide:

1. The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, literary, scientific and educational purposes as set forth in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or successor provision, including, for such purposes, making distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, but only to the extent and in such manner that the purpose constitutes an exempt purpose.

The remaining provisions in Article III shall remain unchanged. Article 12 of the Articles of Incorporation shall be deleted in its entirety.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees hereby amend Article 1, Section 2.a. of the Bylaws of the Company to provide as follows:

a. Distributions. The Trustees shall distribute so much or all of the trust property of THE LEE MERRICK FOUNDATION exclusively for such one or more "exempt purposes" from time to time and in such proportions as the Distribution Committee shall direct. The Charitable Foundation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, religious, scientific, literary or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or successor

provision. Distributions shall be made only to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and only to the extent and in such manner that the purpose constitutes an exempt purpose.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees hereby amend Article 2, Section 2.a. of the Bylaws of the Company to provide as follows:

a. Making distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Sections 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, but only to the extent and in such manner that the purpose constitutes an exempt purpose.

The remaining provisions of Article 2, Section 2 of the Bylaws of the Company shall remain unchanged.
