Part IX-A summary of direct charitable activities:

1. The Foundation was organized on August 26, 2010 and was incorporated as a Virginia non-stock not-for-profit corporation on August 30, 2010. The Foundation is a 501(c)(3) tax exempt grant-making non-operating private foundation devoted to charitable, scientific, literary and educational purposes, particularly the care of and prevention of cruelty to animals, the support of the arts, and the support of childhood education through the encouragement, recognition and reward, by means of scholarships, fellowships, prizes and/or awards, of outstanding or exceptional academic achievement, primarily by elementary, middle and secondary school students and teachers, particularly in the areas of physics, chemistry, mathematics, the performing and fine arts, reading, language and literature.

During fiscal 2014, the Board of Directors approved the award of two grants payable to two charitable organizations. An \$1800.00 grant went to the educational organization, An Achievable Dream, Inc., and a grant of \$200 went to a local public television station, WHRO Public Media.

Part IX-A continued:

An Achievable Dream operates two public schools in an economically depressed area of Newport News, VA. Its mission is to provide the facilities, support, programs and special attention necessary to foster improved educational opportunities for disadvantaged children of the area. The Foundation's \$1800 grant provided money to fund "The Nora & Neil Monahan Reading Achievement Awards," a series of \$25 awards to 1st through 5th grade students who demonstrated the greatest improvement in their basic reading skills during the 2013-2014 school year; "The Anna & Nelson Becci Awards for Outstanding Academic Achievement," a series of 3x\$150 awards to the 11th & 12th grade students who demonstrated the most outstanding or exceptional success and achievement in the study of mathematics, physics, and chemistry during the school year; and "The Channing & Coca Barron Awards for Outstanding Teaching," two \$200 awards to the elementary and middle/high school teachers who best demonstrated, during the school year, outstanding or exceptional success and achievement in inspiring children to study hard, to cultivate an interest in learning, and to achieve their best performance.

Financial support for organizations such as An Achievable Dream exemplify the very essence of the Foundation's core mission. The Board of Directors has already announced that it will continue its support for the academic achievement and teaching awards in 2015.

WHRO Public Media is owned and operated by a consortium of Hampton Roads area public school systems to bring quality educational radio and television programming to the local communities. It broadcasts many leading programs of the Public Broadcasting Services network including NOVA, Masterpiece and Great Performances.

Part X line 4 cash held for charitable activities:

Since the Foundation just began operations at the end of 2010, its assets consist primarily of small amounts of cash and investments. It is the current intention of the Board of Directors to award grants during 2015 that have a higher total value than those awarded in 2014, perhaps \$2500. In addition, the Treasurer is of the opinion that at least another \$1000 of the Foundation's cash balance may be needed during 2015 for administrative and operating expenses. Therefore, the sum of \$3500 has been deemed "held for charitable activities" in Part X line 4 even though this amount exceeds the 1½% general rule.
