

Rock Bridge High School Show Choir Boosters

II.

The Rock Strage High School Snow Choir Boosters is a nonprofit public benefit corporation. The period of duration for the RBHS Show Choir Boosters is perpetual.

III.

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of the Rock Bridge High School Show Choir Boosters shall be to support the RBHS Show Choir program through organizational coordination, volunteer services and fundraising efforts designed to secure suitable, adequate financial backing that would be otherwise unavailable to the program.

IV.

#### Membership

Any one interested in the welfare of the RBHS Show Choir program and the development of programs thereof shall be eligible for membership.

٧.

#### Officers

The officers of this organization will include president, secretary, and treasurer. The current Director of Vocal Music Programs at RBHS will serve as an ex-officio member of the executive committee. The officers will serve as the executive committee of the RBHS Show Choir Boosters.

VI.

#### **Elections**

The executive committee will nominate a state of officers for the next school year. This state of officers will be presented during the first meeting of the RBHS Show Choir Boosters at the beginning of each school year.

VII.

#### **Duties of Officers**

Section A. President shall preside at all meetings and provide leadership to the organization; shall appoint – committee members; countersign checks in the absence of the Treasurer.

Section B. Secretary shall be responsible for recording minutes at all meetings of the organization and provide them when requested. This person will attend to all correspondence on behalf of the organization as directed by the board of directors.

Section C. Treasurer shall receive all funds due the organization, deposit same, pay all authorized bills as directed by the executive committee, and submit records for audit at the conclusion of each school year.

VIII.

## Steering Committee

Section A. The Steering Committee of this organization will be comprised of the executive committee and no more than 8 at-large members that shall be appointed by the executive committee.

Section B. The steering committee shall have the power to act on all urgent matters for the membership between the meetings of this organization.

#### IX.

## Meetings

General meetings of the organization will be open to all members of said organization. At least two meetings will be held annually; one at the beginning of the school year and a second one prior to the major fundraising activity. Additional meetings may be called as deemed necessary by the executive committee. A majority of the members present at an announced meeting shall constitute a quorum. Meetings will not be required to follow Robert's Rules of Order.

## **Assets and Property**

All property acquired by RBHS Show Choir Boosters shall become property of the RBHS Vocal Music Department. The assets of the organization will be distributed upon dissolution as a donation to the RBHS Vocal Music Department.

#### **Amendments**

The by-laws may be amended by a majority vote of the members present at a General Meeting of the organization.
