As shown in paragraph D above, the sum of the Foundation's cash distributions during its start-up payment period was **\$2,092,000** which exceeded the start-up payment period minimum amount.

The Foundation's "full payment period" is January 1, 1997 through December 31, 2014. The "full payment minimum amount" is the sum of 100% of the distributable amount for all years in the full payment period, which is **\$15,641,224**. As shown above, the sum of the cash distributions made by the Foundation during its full payment period is **\$16,610,418** which exceeds the full payment minimum amount.
