In general terms, HCSF's Trustees must deliver substantial value along several broad fronts.

- The Trustees must oversee the development of HCSF's investment management strategies and must ensure that the most appropriate investment management tactics are utilized whenever practicable; to do this, the Trustees must monitor, analyze and interpret short-term and long-term trends in the relevant financial markets, and must actupon those trends in a timely and responsible manner.
- The Trustees must develop a clear philanthropic agenda for HCSF, and must make certain that every dimension of the agenda is supported by an appropriate set of initiatives; the Trustees must consistently develop and implement any and all required initiatives in a timely, focused and cost-effective manner.
- As a practical matter, the Trustees at HCSF must design and execute all of the policies, plans and programs that are required to support the organization's continued ability to serve as an agent of change for the communities that it serves and must do so without the help of a traditional management team.
