Conflicts of interest discovered once a transaction is in process will be addressed by the Board as soon as possible, and the interested person may be subject to discipline, including termination, for failure to disclose the conflict in a timely manner.

[Separate counsel was retained in 2011 by the Trustees to assist with the development of the employment agreement between the Museum and the CEO which extends through calendar year 2014.] Subsequently, the Compensation Committee makes a compensation recommendation which is shared with the Executive Committee for approval. The Executive Committee then approves or amends the recommendation of the Compensation Committee, this occurred in March of 2014 (rate was retroactive to January 1, 2014). The final decision is then shared with the CEO. The Chair then reports to the Board, in private Executive Session, what the Executive Committee and Compensation Committee have determined.
