PRIOR TO THE MERGER THE HEALTHCARE FOUNDATION OF HIGHLAND PARK, F/K/A HIGHLAND PARK HOSPITAL FOUNDATION, WAS CLASSIFIED AS A SUPPORTING ORGANIZATION OF THE HOSPITAL. AS PART OF, AND A CONDITION PRECEDENT TO, THE MERGER OF HIGHLAND PARK HOSPITAL AND NUH, A FOUNDATION AGREEMENT WAS EXECUTED BY THE FOUNDATION AND NUH OBLIGATING IT TO SUPPORT INDIGENT HEALTHCARE AT NUH AND OTHER PUBLICLY SUPPORTED HEALTHCARE ORGANIZATIONS IN HIGHLAND PARK ILLINOIS AND THE SURROUNDING COMMUNITIES IN ORDER TO HELP SUSTAIN THE HEALTHCARE MISSION OF THE HOSPITAL IN HIGHLAND PARK. THE MERGER AGREEMENT OBLIGATED THE FOUNDATION TO MAKE MINIMUM CONTRIBUTIONS TO NUH FOR UNCOMPENSATED EMERGENCY ROOM CARE AND OTHER SIMILAR CLINICAL PROGRAMS. FOR YEARS AFTER 2003, THE MINIMUM CONTRIBUTION DIRECTLY TO NUH IS THE GREATER OF \$4,000,000 OR 50% OF THE FOUNDATION'S INVESTMENT EARNINGS. IN ADDITION, MONETARY SUPPORT TO OTHER ORGANIZATIONS WHICH HELP TO SUSTAIN THE HEALTHCARE MISSION OF NUH WERE \$2,206,944. TOTAL SUPPORT EXCEEDED 100% OF THE FOUNDATION'S NET INVESTMENT INCOME FOR THE YEAR 2014. BASED ON THE FOREGOING FACTS, THE HEALTHCARE FOUNDATION OF HIGHLAND PARK CONTINUES TO BE A TYPE II SUPPORTING ORGANIZATION OF NORTHSHORE UNIVERSITY HEALTHSYSTEM.
