The Fund Administrator (appointed by the site's Chief Executive) and ACF have a joint fiduciary responsibility to use all gifts consistent with the donors' intent. The Fund Administrators approve transfers from Restricted Funds. They are provided with monthly accounting reports showing each Fund's assets, liabilities, new gifts and transfers out. Any transfer from a Restricted Fund of \$5,000 or more must have an approval from an ACF Vice President verifying that the use is consistent with donors' intent. Restricted gifts are directly to ACF's separate bank account for accounting within an appropriate restricted fund from the time of receipt. Within a few days of deposit of each gift, for all gifts of \$5 or more, the donor receives a letter from ACF with the amount of the gift and the name of the restricted fund for the gift, including the name of the related hospital. No payment is made directly from a restricted fund and all purchases have to be made through Advocate Health Care's accounts payable staff subject to system policies and internal controls. Operating expenses are charged to a hospital department and are subject to review through the monthly accounting reports. No compensation is paid to an Advocate employee except through the payroll system. Capital expenditures are reviewed and controlled by the site VP/Director of Finance. Transfers are reviewed for appropriate use. Internal Audit periodically conducts internal control audits of the gifts processing and fund accounting processes.
