- (b) The amounts set aside have been paid for the specific project described in paragraph (a) above within 60 months after the date of the set-aside (December 31, 2009).
- (c) The specific project described in paragraph (a) above was not completed before the end of 2009, the taxable year in which the set-aside was made.
- (d) The distributable amounts of the Foundation as determined under IRC 4942(d) for all past years of the Foundation since its creation:

(f) The "Start-up payment period" for the Foundation is January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1997, and its "Start-up period minimum amount" is: (20% of \$39,599) + (40% of \$93,758) + (60% of \$128,836) + (80% of \$165,545), or \$255,160.60. As shown above, the sum of the Foundation's cash distributions during its start-up payment period is \$1,938,000, which exceeds the start-up period minimum amount.

The Foundation's full-payment period is January 1, 1998 through December 31, 2014. The full-payment minimum amount is the sum of 100% of the distributable amounts for all years in the full-payment period, which as shown in paragraph (d) on the previous page is \$2,961,443.
