- 2. ONLY RESIDENTS OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA ARE ELIGIBLE TO BE RECIPIENTS OF THESE SCHOLARSHIPS. ELIGIBLE STUDENTS ARE THOSE WHO ARE PLANNING TO ATTEND OR ARE ATTENDING ANY ACCREDITED UNITED STATES COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY GRANTING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING DEGREES: BACHELORS, MASTERS, DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY, DOCTOR OF MEDICINE, DOCTOR OF DENTISTRY, DOCTOR OF LAWS, DOCTOR OF VETERINARY MEDICINE OR OTHER COMMONLY ACCEPTED ACCREDITED ADVANCED DEGREES.
- PERSONS OF BOTH SEXES AND ALL AGES, RACES AND RELIGIONS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE THESE SCHOLARSHIPS. SELECTION SHALL BE BASED ON SCHOLASTIC ACHIEVEMENT OR THE POTENTIAL TO MAKE SCHOLASTIC ACHIEVEMENTS, FINANCIAL NEED AND DEMONSTRATED QUALITY OF LEADERSHIP.
