Community Support and Advisory Council (CSAC):

As the lead-agency for the community component of the Sheridan Model Therapeutic Prison, TARGET Area developed a Community Support and Advisory Council (CSAC) in order to engage residents in relationships with reentering prisoners and their families in an effort to define barriers to reentry and to inform policy campaigns aimed at this population.

Neighborhood Recovery Initiative (NRI):

Provides direct services to youth 13-24 that are currently on parole. As well as referral services to clients such as housing, employment, education, and substance abuse treatment. Come in for an Orientation today. We are motivated to help formerly incarcerated individuals return home successful.

Safety Networks:

For the past 3 years, The Safety Net Works at TARGET Area has serviced more than 250 youth in areas of education, employment placement, leadership building, public issues awareness, and empowering them in governmental affairs. In that time we have placed over 200 youth in summer and year-round employment, assisted 30 dropouts with GED obtainment or placement back into school, trained some 200 youth in areas of public safety, leadership abilities, and teambuilding, and mentored 50 youth on a weekly basis.
