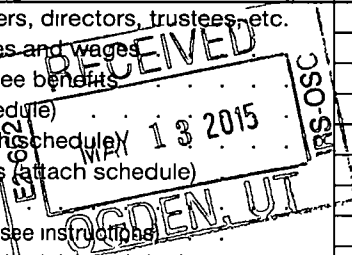

The Foundation awards scholarships to Illinois high school students selected to the Illinois High School Association's "All-State Academic Team" ("Team") consisting of 26 students. Students are selected to the Team based on academic achievement, participation in high school athletics, and community service.

Illinois high school students wishing to be named to the Team must be nominated by their high schools. To be nominated, students must submit an application form to their high school (the application forms are available at the high schools). Students are nominated by the high schools based on (1) scholastic standing, (2) participation in high school athletics, (3) community service, and (4) two letters of recommendation. Nominees are evaluated by a committee of high school principals from each school division, and 26 nominees are selected to the Team.

The number and amount of scholarships awarded by the Foundation depends on the amount of funds available. In 2014, sufficient funds were available to award \$1,000 scholarships to each of the 26 students selected to the Team. In future years, if more funds are available, the Foundation will award larger scholarships to the students on the Team and/or will award scholarships to students who qualify as "honorable mentions." If less funds are available, the Foundation will award smaller scholarships, or the Foundation will determine the number of scholarships and then hold a drawing among the 26 students selected to the Team to determine scholarship winners.
