ONE OF THE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION'S STRENGTHS IS THAT OUR GOVERNANCE IS STRUCTURED TO ENGAGE KEY COMMUNITY LEADERS FROM ALL BUSINESS ASPECTS AND GEOGRAPHIC AREAS OF THE COUNTY. GIVEN THIS APPROACH AND THE FACT THAT OUR BOARD IS FAIRLY LARGE IN COMPARISON (AT 29 VOTING MEMBERS), THERE INEVITABLY WILL BE SOME SITUATIONS WHERE A RELATIONSHIP MAY ARISE. TO MANAGE CASH NEEDS UNDER FDIC LIMITS, THE FOUNDATION MAINTAINS DEPOSIT ACCOUNTS AT MOST AREA FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS. ALTHOUGH THE FOUNDATION WOULD TYPICALLY ENGAGE THE SERVICES OF INDEPENDENT ATTORNEYS WHEN NECESSARY, IN THE CAPACITY OF TRUSTEE, THESE THREE DO SERVE ON THE FOUNDATION'S TECHNICAL ADVISOR COMMITTEE GIVEN THEIR EXPERTISE AND KNOWLEDGE, AND FROM TIME TO TIME MAY PROVIDE LEGAL COUNSEL ON GENERAL MATTERS SHOULD SUCH MATTERS ARISE. 3) TWO OTHER TRUSTEES SERVE AS EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS OF SEPARATE NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS WHICH HAVE BEEN RECIPIENTS OF 2014 COMMUNITY FOUNDATION GRANT AWARDS---DENISE BROOKS OF THE YMCA AND MICHAEL MCCARTEN OF ST. CLAIR COUNTY COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH. ANOTHER TRUSTEE IS THE PRESIDENT OF BAKER COLLEGE, WITH WHOM WE MAY COLLABORATE WITH ON CHARITABLE EDUCATION INITIATIVES. A FEW OTHER TRUSTEES ARE BOARD MEMBERS ON SCHOOL/COLLEGE/NON-PROFIT/COUNTY BOARDS FOR WHOSE SCHOOLS/DEPARTMENTS/ORGANIZATINOS RECEIVED GRANTS IN 2014. UNDER BOARD GRANTING AUTHORITY DELEGATION, THESE GRANTS WERE INDEPENDENTLY REVIEWED, RECOMMENDED AND APPROVED BY BOARD-APPROVED GRANTING COMMITTEES OUTSIDE OF THESE TRUSTEES.
