In addition, the Soup Kitchen hosts a monthly Coffeehouse program on the third Saturday of every month at 6:30pm. The Coffeehouse ministry offers a meal and fellowship in a clean, wholesome environment for those who wish to change their lifestyle and form new relationships. Live entertainment, Christ-centred teaching or games are provided after dinner is served.

### Jail and Prison Ministry

A team of MOD volunteers regularly visits the Midland County Jail and Freeland Correctional Facility to pray with inmates and to share the good news of Jesus Christ with them. Through collaboration with the Midland County Jail, one-on-one prayer visits and group Sunday services are offered to male and female inmates (separately) each week. Volunteers also distribute bibles and devotional materials through the jail and prison administration as needed.

### RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MIDLAND'S OPEN DOOR

Pursuant to the provisions of the Michigan Nonprofit Corporations Act, Act 162, Public Acts of 1982 (the "Act"), as amended, corporation executes the following articles:

### ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is MIDLAND'S OPEN DOOR.

### ARTICLE II

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are: The corporation is formed exclusively for charitable, religious, literary, educational, and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, including for such purposes:

- Providing a Christian, non-denominational outreach; (a)
- Providing meals for free to indigent and low-income people in (b) Midland County, Michigan;
- Providing clothing for free to indigent and low-income people in Midland County, Michigan;
- Providing crisis shelter for homeless people in Midland (c) County, Michigan;
- Providing religious and restoration ministry services to people in the Midland County, Michigan region, who are either incarcerated or who have been recently released from prison, jail, or substance abuse programs;
- Providing such other ancillary services designed to address (e) the physical and spiritual needs of indigent individuals,
- Distributing property to qualified charitable organizations; For purposes of these Articles, the term "qualified charitable organization" shall mean an organization which is described in Section 170(c)(1) or (2) of the Code; and

Performing any and all lawful activities that may be incidental (g) to or reasonably necessary for accomplishing the foregoing purposes.

### ARTICLE III

The corporation is organized upon a non-stock, directorship basis.

The corporation possesses the following assets:

Real property: Buildings valued at \$351,777. Personal property: Furniture, fixtures, and equipment valued at \$24,219.

The corporation is to be financed under the following general plan: donations, gifts-in-kind, and grants.

### ARTICLE IV

### ARTICLE V

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its directors, officers, or other private persons. However, the corporation shall be authorized to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in article II. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. The corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing and distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision

of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code or (2) by a corporation whose contributions are deductible under section IRC 170(c)(2) or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

### **ARTICLE VI**

On dissolution of the corporation, after paying or providing for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, the corporation's assets shall be distributed (1) for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code or (2) to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the circuit court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations that the court shall determine and that are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

### **ARTICLE VII**

When a compromise, an arrangement, or a plan of reorganization is proposed between this corporation and its creditors, a court of equity jurisdiction within this state may order a meeting of the affected creditors. The corporation, a creditor of the corporation, or a receiver appointed for the corporation may apply to the court for a meeting. The meeting shall be summoned in such manner as the court directs. If a majority in number representing 3/4 in value of the affected creditors agree to a compromise or arrangement, the compromise, arrangement, or reorganization of this corporation resulting from the compromise or arrangement, if approved by the court, shall be binding on all the creditors, and also on this corporation.

### **ARTICLE VIII**

No member of the board of directors of the corporation who is a volunteer director, as that term is defined in the Michigan Nonprofit Corporation Act (the "Act"), or a volunteer officer shall be personally liable to this corporation for monetary damages for a breach of the director's or officer's fiduciary duty, provided, however, that this provision shall not eliminate or limit the liability of a director or officer for any of the following:

- a breach of the director's or officer's duty of loyalty to the corporation; 1.
- acts or omissions not in good faith or that involve intentional misconduct or 2 a knowing violation of law;
- 3. a violation of section 551(1) of the Act;
- a transaction from which the director or officer derived an improper 4. personal benefit:
- an act or omission occurring before the filing of these articles of 5. incorporation: or
- an act or omission that is grossly negligent. 6.

The corporation assumes all liability to any person, other than the corporation, for all acts or omissions of a director who is a volunteer director, as defined in the Act, or a volunteer officer incurred in the good faith performance of the director's or officer's duties. However, the corporation shall not be considered to have assumed any liability to the extent that such assumption is inconsistent with the status of the corporation as an organization described in IRC 501(c)(3) or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

If the Act is amended after the filing of these articles of incorporation to authorize the further elimination or limitation of the liability of directors or officers of nonprofit corporations, then the liability of members of the board of directors or officers, in addition to that described in article IX, shall be assumed by the corporation or eliminated or limited to the fullest extent permitted by the Act as so amended. Such an elimination, limitation, or assumption of liability is not effective to the extent that it is inconsistent with the status of the corporation as an organization described in IRC 501(c)(3) or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. No amendment or repeal of article IX shall apply to or have any effect on the liability or alleged liability of any member of the board of directors or officer of this corporation for or with respect to any acts or omissions occurring before the effective date of any such amendment or repeal.

### ARTICLE IX

The corporation assumes the liability for all acts or omissions of a volunteer if all of the following conditions are met:

- The volunteer was acting or reasonably believed he or she was acting 1. within the scope of his or her authority.
- The volunteer was acting in good faith. 2.
- The volunteer's conduct did not amount to gross negligence or willful and 3. wanton misconduct

- The volunteer's conduct was not an intentional tort. 4.
- The volunteer's conduct was not a tort arising out of the ownership, maintenance, or use of a motor vehicle for which tort liability may be imposed as provided in section 3135 of the Insurance Code of 1956, Act No. 218 of the Public Acts of 1956, being section 500.3135 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

These Restated Articles of Incorporation were duly adopted on the ///day of FEBRUALY, 20 17 in accordance with the provisions of Section 642 of the Act. These Restated Articles of Incorporation restate, integrate, and do further amend the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation and were duly adopted by the members.
