PUBLIC OPINION POLLING

Naturist Education Foundation continued distribution of a nationwide public opinion poll it had commissioned in 2006 and a state-specific opinion survey, which was conducted in California in 2009 by the independent polling firm of Zogby International.

In 2014, NEF initiated further public opinion surveys for publication in 2015.

GRANTS

In 2014, Naturist Education Foundation made grants:

to The Naturist Society for the creation, printing, and distribution of a special issue of *Nude & Natural* (*N*)magazine. NEF contributed to the content.

to Wreck Beach Preservation Society, as a sponsor of a 5 kilometer clothing-optional walk/run that served as an awareness raising event at Wreck Beach in Vancouver, British Columbia.

OUTREACH / INVOLVEMENT

In 2014, Naturist Education Foundation continued its outreach programs

 NEF conducted informational sessions at festivals and gatherings that served those both inside and outside the traditional naturist community.

SPECIAL PROJECTS

During the reported time period, NEF undertook a number of special projects. Those included:

- NEF SCHOLASTIC / JUNIOR SCHOLASTIC AWARD. NEF continued a program of separate awards for naturist college-aged and high school-aged students who submit written works concerning naturism / naturist issues or body acceptance.
- NEF SPEAKERS BUREAU. The Naturist Education Foundation continued a speakers bureau program makes knowledgeable naturist speakers available for informational and educational purposes throughout North America.
- TONI EGBERT NATURIST LAW LIBRARY NEF expanded this online compendium of legal resources on naturist topics. The library is a part of the web site of the Naturist Education Foundation and is open to all.
- NEF RESEARCH LIBRARY. NEF initiated a brick-and-mortar research library in 1,000 square feet of rented office space in Oshkosh, Wisconsin. The library will be open by appointment to naturist researchers and to researchers from the general public.
- CINEMA AU NATUREL. NEF made a second printing of Cinema au Naturel, the
 definitive book on the topic of nudism in film. The book is written by author,
 researcher and lecturer, Mark Storey. NEF was the original publisher of the book.
