## Explanation:

The Foundation is filing an amended return to correct an error on Part X, Line 1A, which was omitted in the Original Return. As amended, the correction amends Parts V, X, XI and XIII, and increases the excise tax on net investment income from \$1114 to \$2228. A tax payment is being made via EFTPS in the amount of the tax due of \$931 which includes a \$1 penalty.
