In the reporting period the IRS audited the information and tax returns of the foundation and parties related to the foundation who are described in the code as "disqualified persons", and that the Service has proposed to revoke the exempt status of the foundation, retroactively, and impose excise tax and income tax fines and penalties against the foundation and its related disqualified persons, on the basis that the foundation and the disqualified persons have engaged in acts of self-dealing by entering into, and maintaining, lease and rental arrangements with each other during recent reporting periods. The foundation and its disqualified persons who are described in the proposal have protested the proposal of the Service, are preparing for an appeal of the proposal, and through their counsel and accounting representatives the foundation and disqualified persons are vigorously contesting the proposal. It is and continues to be the position of the foundation and disqualified persons that the leases and rents paid pursuant to them were approved by the Service, that the Service was notified of this activity as a part of the foundation's tax exempt application and that full disclosure of this activity was included in the administrative record that formed the basis of the foundation's favorable tax exempt determination letter.

The foundation has corrected the lease/rent structure that has given rise to the audit proposal.
